Achievements

National Arena League -

Last Season we placed 3rd overall, narrowly missing out on promotion to division 1 with a massive effort by all the swimmers in all 3 rounds.

This Season we placed 2nd at every round and only by a few points for the last 2 rounds. This should gain us promotion to division 1 next season. No small feat for a club as small as ours, we pack "punch"!

Racing

We had 1 swimmer qualify for Winter Nationals in December 21.

Our swimmers absolutely smashed their swims at Hampshire Counties, yes, we had Dq or 2 but we had so many amazing swims from the swimmers and lots of swimmers making finals in a wide array of events. I think 6 Golds, 15 Silvers and 12 Bronze Medals was a fantastic effort by every one of the swimmers.

We had 13 swimmers qualify for the South East Regionals 2022 which is almost as hard to qualify for than Nationals! which was a fantastic achievement for the swimmers and great progress for the club.

To finish the season off we had Joe M Qualifying for British Championships in May, in the 50 Fly.

Following that in August we had Joe M and James Port Qualifying for English Nationals both in the 50 Fly. A fantastic achievement for them both and us as a club.

Full open meets are back up and running and proving tricky to get in to as they are super popular and were missed badly by the swimmers over the last 18 month.

So far the swimmers competing at the open meets are showing that the hard work and dedication they have put in is paying off. Seeing lots of Personal best times at almost every meet.

We will hopefully have as many swimmers qualify for Counties as we did last year in the age groups and the youth category's, with the swimmers training hard.

We are again hoping to enter a full complement of relay teams to counties, hoping to repeat the success of the relay teams at last year's Counties and maybe even 2 teams in some ages showing the growth and development of the swimmers and the club.
