



2025-26 Membership Details



1. The membership year will run from 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026.
2. Membership details will be held on a system called Team Unify. Members (parents/guardians for those under 18 years of age) will have access to the system via their own accounts. Members will be responsible for ensuring personal information is correct and maintained - especially emergency contact numbers, e-mail address and medical condition/disability details. The club recommends members download the SportsEngine Motion (SE Motion) app to manage their Dolphin membership.
3. The conditions of membership require the acceptance of the club rules, constitution and codes of conduct of Bath Dolphin Swimming Club (as detailed on the website [here](#)).
4. Annual membership fees **must** be fully paid by 7 May 2025.
5. The [membership form](#) **must** be completed by 7 May 2025.
6. Fees can be paid in one go by 7 April 2025 or by a 12-month standing order (by the 7th of each month) as detailed below:

2025-26 Membership Details



Training Sessions:

1. There will be no swimming:
 - a. On Bank Holidays
 - b. February Half Term
 - c. Easter Sunday
 - d. May Half Term
 - e. October Half Term
 - f. Full shutdown for two weeks during school summer holidays to be notified
 - g. Christmas school holidays
2. There will be a reduced timetable:
 - a. For four weeks of the school summer holidays – one session per squad per week (Tuesdays and Wednesdays)

Additional Terms and Conditions:

1. Training fees are due on the 7th of each month.
2. These are annual fees payable monthly (12 payments) based on a minimum of 40 weeks training. There is no option to pay-as-you-swim due to financial commitments the club faces.
3. Movement between membership categories will result in fees changing as appropriate.
4. Any member whose fee is unpaid by the date falling 30 days after the due date will be suspended by the committee from some or all Club activities from a date to be determined by the Committee and until such payment is made. Any missed fees should be paid in full the next calendar month with the next payment. A member whose fee is more than two months in arrears shall be deemed to have resigned (unless granted special dispensation by the Management Committee).
5. In special circumstances Bath Dolphin SC may remit whole or part of the fees due from a member. All such requests must be submitted in writing to the Bath Dolphin SC Honorary Secretary via bathdolphinsecretary@gmail.com for consideration by the appropriate Club Officers.
6. Should circumstances require it, the Committee reserves the right to alter training sessions at any time.
7. Regardless of fees paid, some squads have a minimum commitment on attendance which must be adhered to. Attendance at any training session is at the discretion of the Head Teacher/Coach.
8. For families with three or more members a 25% reduction will be made for the third member and a 50% reduction for further members (based upon the lowest paying member receiving the greatest discount).
9. A one off £60 discount to the fees (per family) is available when a family member becomes a Club volunteer on a regular basis. Bath Dolphin SC also provides financial support to Club Volunteers that wish to undertake swimming related qualifications (e.g. teaching/coaching, timekeeping, judging etc.).
10. Free membership of the Masters squad is offered to all poolside coaches (who coach, on average, two sessions a week) and to committee members. Those entitled should sign up for the Masters squad as usual and liaise with the membership secretary for the discount.
11. Coaches and qualified officials are entitled to claim reimbursement of petrol and parking fees when operating in a formal capacity for the club i.e. officiating at galas, coaching sessions etc.
