Fire	All	Attendees are advised of location of fire exits at start of event	Low	A senior BDSC representative is allotted to make a safety announcement at each event.	Management/ Event Committee	Ongoing as Required
Safeguarding issues	All	BDSC coaching/support staff are vigilant for any safeguarding issues.	Low	BDSC coaching/support staff undergo regular safeguarding training as required.	Relevant BDSC Personnel	Management/ Event Committee
Anti-social behaviour	All	Only BDSC members and their invited guests are allowed to attend event.	Low	All bookings are vetted by the event organisers. Club members sing up to behaviour policies.	Management/ Event Committee	Ongoing
Anti-social behaviour	All	BDSC coaching/support staff are vigilant for any warning signs (e.g. under age drinking).	Low	Vigilance from BDSC chaperones/officers.	Relevant BDSC Personnel	Ongoing as Required
Under 18 left unattended at end of event	Under 18	Check made that all attendees have vacated venue at the end of the event.	Low	Event organiser or nominated person(s) responsible to check venue.	Management/ Event Committee	Ongoing as Required
