Eligibility	Only swimmers registered with Leinster clubs, aged 12 or over , are eligible to enter this gala. Ages are Year of Birth ; as of Dec 31st 2025. Swimmers should have achieved the Consideration Times as indicated below. Entries with NT will be rejected.

	Swimmers who have achieved Consideration Times in any event may be accepted for entry into those events, where time availability allows.					
	QTs and CTs below are provided for SC times, however conversions from LC times will be accepted, and the Hy-Tek meet file will convert as appropriate. Please note that, for 2025, there are no separate CTs provided for the 50m events, or for the 800m and 1500m events. This means that only swimmers who achieve the QTs will be accepted into these events.

12 yr olds	Swim Ireland have agreed to allow 12yr olds to compete in the SC Championships on the following limited basis:				
	 12yr olds must qualify on the basis of the QTs in 200m events only. 12yr olds who qualify on this basis may also enter the 50m event in their stroke(s) of qualification (no CT or QT necessary for this shorter distance) 12yr olds who qualify on the basis of the 200m Free QTs may also enter the 400m Free (no CT or QT necessary for the 400m distance) 				
!! Hy-Tek Team Manager Eligibility Report (and equivalent)	As no CTs or QTs have been defined for 12yr olds for the 50m events or for the 400m Free, the Hy-Tek Team Manager eligibility report (or equivalent) will appear to show that all 12yr olds in a club are eligible to enter these events. This is not correct! Only 12 yr olds who meet the eligibility criteria for the 200m events are allowed to enter. Any other entries received in respect to 12yr old swimmers will be deleted. Swim Ireland Registration Number	A Swim Ireland registration number must be included with every entry. This number is the unique identifier of every swimmer in the national database.				
Entry Name Protocols	The results from this Championship Meet will be added to the Swim Ireland and Leinster databases. To ensure that results get attributed correctly to swimmers, please ensure the format of names within your Team Manager (or similar) database, and provided with entries, is as follows:				
	All those with a Mac/Mc surname need to have a space after the Mac/Mc (e.g. Mac Dougal, Mc Donnell);				
	All those with an O need to be written as e.g. O'Donnell (no space before or after the apostrophe). This is irrespective of whether or not that is how the swimmer normally writes their name.				
Entry Times	Entry times must have been achieved in open competition after May 1st 2024				
Scratches	Scratches for this gala will close at 5pm on Friday November 21 st for Session 1 and 2, and 5pm on Saturday November 22 nd for Sessions 4 and 5. Scratches via email to <u>leinstergalasecretary@swimireland.ie</u> or in person at the gala.				
Heats	Clubs will be notified in advance as to any changes to the competition. Numbers of heats may be curtailed to allow the gala to be run off in a reasonable time-frame.				
Finals	A and B Finals will be run in each 50m, 100m & 200m event. The Finals will be Open; there will not be separate Finals for the different Youth and Senior age categories.

800m and 1500m events	The 800m and 1500m events will be mixed events. In the case of the 800m event, there will be a maximum of four heats, with 20 Open and 20 Female accepted. In the case of the 1500m event, there will be a maximum of two heats, with 10 Open and 10 Female accepted. Swimmers will be allocated places in the heats based on validated entry times.					
Relays	All relay events will be Open-Age; there will not be separate age-group categories for Relay Events. Clubs may enter up to two teams per Relay Events, but may win only one medal per event; e.g. if teams from the same club finish first and third, the bronze medal will be awarded to the fourth-placed team.					
Medals	The first three swimmers in each final will be awarded Leinster championship medals. In addition, a set of medals will be awarded to the leading swimmers in the Youth age group, according to the following criteria:					
	 Youth medal candidates must have qualified for a final (A or B) in the 50m, 100m and 200m events; 					
	Youth swimmers who win championship medals will not be awarded an age-group medal;					
	The top three Youth swimmers (based on times achieved in the Finals, or in the Heats for the HDW events) will be awarded age-group medals.					
Officials	Clubs must provide officials in a ratio of one official to every four swimmers (this includes the senior gala officials). Different arrangements may apply to the rostering of officials for long distance events (800m, 1500m).					
World Aquatics (WA)	This gala will be run under FINA rules. In particular, please note that the regulations relating to FINA-approved swimsuits will be enforced for "tech" swimsuits. However please note that non-tech swimsuits may be worn and do not need to be FINA-approved. Swimmers have a choice between wearing non-tech swimsuits or FINA-approved tech swimsuits.					
Withdrawals	Swimmers must withdraw from finals within 30 minutes of the heat results being announced; failure to scratch from finals will lead to a fine of €20.00					
Complaints	Clubs are reminded that the only club representatives who are permitted to enter a complaint or to otherwise approach the Referee, Meet Director or Gala Recorder are Coaches and Team Managers.					
Code of Conduct	It is a pre-condition to a swimmer being entered for a Leinster Region gala that all parents / guardians who attend and/or assume officiating duties (timekeeping etc) have consented to be subject to the SI Code of Conduct.					
Discrepancies	In the case of any discrepancy or difference between the meet information provided in this document and the meet information provided via the Hy-Tek meet set-up file, the information in this document shall be the definitive information and shall prevail.

In accordance with the Swim Ireland Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy, the categories for competitive swimming are now defined as follows:

- 1. Female – athletes with a birth sex of female
- Open athletes with a birth sex of male, trans or non-binary 2. competitors and any competitor not eligible for the Female category

The documentation for this competition has been prepared to reflect this policy.

Data Protection

Leinster Region, Swim Ireland uses a computer database to manage entries and results of swimming meets, and also to manage competition records of swimmers. By submitting and accepting entries to the meet consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act, to the holding of personal information on Leinster Region computer databases. Personal data held for each swimmer will be name, date of birth, club, Swim Ireland registration number, entry times, achieved times and DQ codes. Certain elements of this data (name, club, age, times, achieved times) may be made public prior to, during or after the meet (e.g. programmes, results, Meet Mobile, etc).
