This applies regardless of whether they intend to enter the summer national event or not. Ages are as of December 31 st 2025

Entry Limits	Swimmers can enter no more than 4 (four) individual events in the meet.				
Consideration Times	There are no Consideration Times for this Meet.

	For the 13+ age groups, there will be a Skins final event for each generate the top eight swimmers, selected based on scoring from three 100m eduring the heats. The Skins will be an eliminator event; the slowest swimmers after each round. Rounds will be 50m with the stroke to be selected by lot for each round.			
	For the 9-12 year olds, there wlll be a "Super Final" in each age-group (9/10, 11 and 12yrs) and gender for the top ten swimmers, selected based on scoring from three 50m events during the heats. These Super Finals will be swum as 100m I.M. events. Coaches should ensure that all qualifiers for these Super Finals are capable of swimming all four strokes competently.			
Session Start Times	The Start Times of sessions as indicated in the Order of Events may be changed in the light of entries received and the logistics of running the Meet within Swim Ireland regulations relating to Session duration etc.			



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Officials	Clubs must provide officials in a ratio of one official to every four swimmers for each session (this includes the senior gala officials). A rota for club officials will be circulated as early as possible in advance of the meet.
Swim Ireland Registration Number	A Swim Ireland registration number must be included with every entry. This number is the unique identifier of every swimmer in the national database.
Swim Ireland Gender Policy	In accordance to the Swim Ireland Transgender and Non-Binary Participation and Competition Policy, <u>HERE</u> , this competition will be conducted within relevant age specific groups and will be conducted in two categories:
	 Female: athletes with a birth sex of Female. Open: athletes with a birth sex of Male, trans or non-binary competitors and any competitor not eligible for the Female category.
Entry Name Protocols	The results from all Leinster meets are added to the Swim Ireland and/or Leinster databases. To ensure that results get attributed correctly to swimmers, please ensure the format of names within your Team Manager (or similar) database, and provided with entries, is as follows:
	All those with a Mac/Mc surname need to have a space after the Mac/Mc (e.g. Mac Dougal, Mc Donnell);
	All those with an O need to be written as e.g. O'Donnell (no space before or after the apostrophe). This is irrespective of whether or not that is how the swimmer normally writes their name.
Complaints	Clubs are reminded that the only club representatives who are permitted to enter a complaint or to otherwise approach the Referee, Meet Director or Gala Recorder are Coaches and Team Managers
Code of Conduct	It is a pre-condition to a swimmer being entered for a Leinster Region gala that all parents / guardians who attend and/or assume officiating duties (timekeeping etc) have consented to be subject to the SI Code of Conduct.
Data Protection	Leinster Region, Swim Ireland uses a computer database to manage entries and results of swimming meets, and also to manage competition records of swimmers. By submitting and accepting entries to the meet consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act, to the holding of personal information on Leinster Region computer databases. Personal data held for each swimmer will be name, date of birth, club, Swim Ireland registration number, entry times, achieved times and DQ codes. Certain elements of this data (name, club, age, times, achieved times) may be made public prior to, during or after the meet (e.g. programmes, results, Meet Mobile, etc).
