

Pool:	8 Lane, 25m Pool, Electronic Timing, Olympic standard blocks. A secondary strobe will be available at this meet.
Age Groups:	9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over. Age as at 7 th July 2024 For event restrictions see qualifying times below.
Awards:	Heat declared winners with awards to top three in each age group. Heats will run slowest to fastest seeded times. Spot prizes will be given in each event.
Events:	50m, 100m and 200m all strokes, 100m and 200m IM.
Fees:	£7 per event for club entries via Sportysys£7.50 per event for individual online entries
Specators:	Spectator Entry £6 per session or £10 all day.
Entries to:	Entries will be accepted via Sportsys file or online form <u>ONLY</u> . Entries with NT will be accepted, estimated times may be provided in place of NT entries (but are not required).

Closing Date for Entries: 12.00 Midnight on 7th June 2024

Timings noted above are indicative and may alter slightly. Final timings will be confirmed shortly before the meet.

Meet Rules and Information

General Conditions

- 1. This Competition is licensed by Swim England and will be held under Swim England Laws and Regulations, Technical Rules of Racing, World Aquatics Technical Rules of Swimming and the following Meet Rules.
- 2. Entrants must be Swim England registered Category Compete, belong to an affiliated club and enter in the name of one club only.
- 3. The meet promoter has the right to amend the program or timings to ensure the smooth running and fairness of the event.
- 4. The overall meet promoter is Tone Klausen however a different person may be designated as promoter for each session on the day. Questions/queries regarding this meet should be directed, in the first instance, to the promoter at meets@cocsc.org.uk.
- 5. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to Swim England Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules of Racing.

Age Groups

- 6. Competitors' ages shall be as of 7th July 2024
- 7. The age groups for each event will be 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over.

Fees

- 8. Race entry fee is £7 per event when entered as a team (Sportsys file)
- 9. Individual online entry is £7.50 per event (via individual entry link)
- 10. Spectator fees are **£6** per session or **£10** per day.
- 11. Coach/Team Manager passes are £16.00 per day (includes lunch)

Awards

- 12. Medals will be awarded to the top three in each age group in each event based on heat declared winner
- **13.** Spot prizes will be awarded to randomly selected heat winners. A spot prize heat will be identified prior to the start of the race with a ringing bell. All spot prizes will be awarded at the promoter's discretion.

Entries

- 14. Entry forms and payment must be received by the Promoters before midnight on Friday 7th June 2024 and must be fully and correctly completed, or else they may be rejected.
- **15.** All entries of three or more swimmers must be made via club entry. Electronic SPORTSYSTEMS Entry Manager files are available on request by e-mail to <u>meets@cocsc.org.uk</u> or from the club website at <u>www.cocsc.org.uk</u>. There will be an administration charge of **£20** for group entries not submitted via meet entry file.
- **16.** Individual entries must be made via an online form, linked here: <u>https://swim-meet.com/Entry/Cambridge/.</u> Please check first if your club is entering before submitting an individual entry.
- 17. Entries will only be accepted once payment has been received.
- 18. The list of accepted and rejected entries will be published/available for download on the club website (<u>www.cocsc.org.uk</u>) approximately two weeks prior to the competition. It is the competing club/swimmer's responsibility to check this list for accuracy and advise immediately of any mistakes or changes that are required.

Qualifying times and entry standards

- 19. All entry times must meet the qualifying times and criteria stated on the qualifying times below.
- **20.** Swimmers in possession of a Swim England Certificate of Swimming Disability or whose Swim England membership record details a disability sport class are welcome to enter the competition with a time slower than the lower limit standard. An entry time must be provided.

Over-subscription and rejections

- 21. This is a first come first serve meet.
- 22. Competitors may be rejected if the meet is oversubscribed in order to meet license time guidelines.
- 23. The promoter reserves the right to limit entries and the number of heats in any event to maintain a balanced programme.
- 24. In the event that entries are rejected, fees will be refunded by a single payment to club in question. Individual entries will be refunded to the individual's bank account.

Withdrawals and refunds

- 25. Swimmers <u>must</u> withdraw from any events that they no longer wish to swim. All swimmers informed of having accepted entries will be deemed as competing unless they have informed the promoter that they do not wish to swim.
- 26. Each club should have their own record of swimmers entered, and swimmers unable to compete must be withdrawn.
- 27. Withdrawals must be done online by using the Swim-Meet withdrawal link provided by the promoter before the meet.
- **28.** Any on the day withdrawals must be made by coaches or the club representative any time up to 5 minutes after the start of each warm-up for the relevant session.
- **29.** No refunds will be made for withdrawals after the publication of the Accepted list other than for injury or illness with a medical certificate. Any competitor that withdraws on medical grounds will not be permitted to participate in any events for the remainder of that session.

Fines

30. Any swimmer failing to report to the marshalling area for their event, and subsequently missing their event will be fined **£10** which must be paid before they can join any other events they have been entered into.

Coaches and team managers

- **31.** Coaches/Team Managers will be allowed on poolside if wearing a pre-purchased pass. These passes include admittance to the poolside for all sessions and lunch on the day.
- **32.** Coaches and Team Managers must be club trained personnel and clubs are asked to maintain the recommended ratio of helpers to swimmers in line with SE guideline. Untrained parents without DBS or Safeguarding clearance are not allowed on poolside.
- **33.** Clubs are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that swimmers entered under their name are supervised, at all times, by coaches/ team managers/chaperones in compliance with the Swim England Team manager, Coach and Chaperone Policy.

Pool information and Starts

- **34.** The pool length is 25 metres, 8 lanes with anti-wave ropes and electronic timing and the depth of the pool is 1.2m at the shallow end and 1.8m at the deep end. Dives into depths between 1.2m and 1.35 metres are allowed from the poolside or starting block, as long it is not more than 0.75m above the water. If the water is between one metre and 1.2 metres, a poolside dive will be permitted providing it is not from more than 0.4 metres above the surface. All starts and changes during relay races are into 1.35m of water.
- **35.** In accordance with with the Swim England guidance of 8/12/2022 it is not permitted to dive at the shallow end of the pool. All races will start at the deep end; there are no relay events in this gala.
- **36.** Backstroke starting ledges may be used at the discretion of the meet promoter.
- **37.** A secondary strobe will be available and in use at this meet.
- **38.** All events will be seeded on submitted times, and all heats will be spearheaded. The first three swimmers in each event in each age group will receive awards.
- **39.** Over the top starts may be used at the referees' discretion.

Warm-up

40. Warm up protocol: Strictly no diving during any warm-up sessions, except in the designated sprint lanes, odd lanes will swim clockwise (1, 3, 5, 7) even lanes (2, 4, 6, 8) will swim Anti clockwise. All swimmers must leave the water by the side of the pool and not over the timing pads. Coaches must manage the lanes their swimmers are using during the warm-up sessions. Guidance will be given by the meet announcer & warm up Marshals.

Officials

41. CoCSC welcome all officials including trainees. Officials can register directly online the sign-up link page.

Photography

- **42**. In accordance with Swim England Child Safety Procedures and Policies all parents or carers of swimmers under the age of 18 who wish to take photo, or video images are requested to focus on their own child as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in those images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends through social media platforms. Should you have any concerns about photography or filming at this event then please bring them to the attention of the Meet Promoter in attendance.
- 43. There can be **no cameras or phones** in any of the changing rooms.

Spectators

- 44. Limited seating poolside will be available for Coaches and swimmers. No additional seating is permitted poolside or in the gallery.
- 45. The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor, participant, coach or spectator

Results

46. Results will be available on the results link. This link will be distributed before/at the meet.

Safety

- 47. The promoters do not accept responsibility for any property damage, theft or loss thereof.
- **48.** For Health and Safety reasons only small rucksack bags will be allowed poolside. Lockers are available (refundable £1 coin required). Pool staff will remove any large obtrusive bags.
- **49.** Access to poolside is restricted to competitors for the session, coaches/team managers with a poolside pass, technical officials and appointed volunteers. Parents are not permitted access to poolside.
- 50. Glass items are not allowed on poolside.

Data Protection

51. By submitting and accepting entries to the meet, consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information on computer. Personal data handled such as name, club, recorded and entered times may be made public during or after the meet.

Transgender Competition Policy

- **52.** Entries will be made using Female and Open/Male competition categories in accordance with the Swim England Transgender and Non-binary Competition Policy on 1 September.
- **53.** The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

Para Swimming Conditions

The conditions outlined above shall apply to all para swimmers except were varied by any of the following conditions.

- 1. Swimmers with S1- S15(S14) classifications will be accepted.
- 2. All para swimmers must have an internationally authorised classification.
- 3. Competitors must be registered members of Swim England.
- 4. Personal care attendants will be permitted Poolside for swimmers in all disability classes.
- 5. A swimmer may have both a coach and a personal care attendant present Poolside.
- 6. The competition format will be based on disability inclusion within the able-bodied programme. Swimmers will be integrated on a time-banded basis in all events.
- 7. Positions will be determined by each swimmer's times relative to the world record in their own classification.
- 8. Para swimmers will be included but not placed within the results for the appropriate age group in the able-bodied competition unless their entry times meet the qualifying times for the able-bodied competition. They will also be included in the multi-class results and placed within those results according to their equivalent times.
- 9. Competition to be run under IPC Swimming rules.
- 10. Medals shall be awarded on a multi-class basis to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each event.

Qualifying Times

Swimmers time must be slower than the Qualifying time

Qualification times must have been achieved at any meet since 1st Jan 2023, converted to 25m pool if necessary. All entry times will automatically be checked against British Rankings for validity.

Entries with "No Time" will be accepted, and estimated times may be provided in place of NT entries (but are not required).
