TREASURER'S REPORT ON THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2023

Financially the Club had a successful year, seeming to recover from the financial impact of Covid-19. The surplus for the year was £10,260. Reserves are therefore up to £42,127, of which £39,035 is in the bank. Whilst this may sound significant, our monthly pool hire costs alone are £6k.

INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

Subscription income is back up to pre-Covid levels, and many of our squads are full.

We were able to host two of our own meets during the year (in November and March) which generated around £10,000 of profits for the Club. These events make a huge difference to the Club's finances and help to keep monthly fees down. Your support for these events is much appreciated.

Pool costs are continuing to be a huge outlay for the club and these costs are continuing to rise as energy costs increase.
