MEETS NEWS

A number of our swimmers returned to competing at the end of last year at the ND Age Groups in Oct/Nov, Orkney Mini Meet and the Scottish Winter Meet Well done to all the swimmers lots of PB's with 3 swimmers receiving certificates for finishing in the top 3 in their age groups for some of theirs swims. Orkney Mini Meet was also a success with our swimmers coming home with a number of medals.

There are upcoming meets in January and February. We have 6 swimmers competing at the upcoming Buckie Meet, some eligible swimmers for the ND and the closing date for Elgin Spring Meet for entries is Wed 26th January. For eligible swimmers the ND Age Group Championships inc Midland District Age Group Championships are being held in Aberdeen in March and SNAGS will be held at Tollcross, Glasgow in April. We hope that the club will have some eligible swimmers for SNAGS. The club are also hoping to host a graded meet in April and there will hopefully be a number of meets over the next few months, including mini meets for our younger and less experienced swimmers. If your swimmer is competing soon and you have not already done so, please put yourself forward for the upcoming Timekeeping course.
