





VOLUNTEER VACANCIES

Please read this – it shows current IASC vacancies as well as information on Technical official Roles. This is updated on a regular basis.

Swimming is a very interactive sport when it comes to parent participation, without which there is no swimming club or competitions. Aside from the Head Coach, all roles are carried out by volunteers. There are a number of roles within Swimming Club structures whether that be general volunteers, Committee members or on poolside. IASC constantly need volunteers and as a member you will be required to assist either on poolside or dryside. Each administrative role can be split into smaller roles allowing for more members to become involved and also to share the workload. This also allows for resilience and future planning.

Within the competitive structure of swimming, the general acceptance for parents is that when taking part in competitions away from Inverness, at least one parent should be volunteering (at home meets, officials are sought from other clubs attending). As a general rule of thumb, at least one parent will be expected to be a time keeper. Time keeper courses are run locally and very simple to pass. If you can see a stopwatch and press a button then you can pass!!! Our Technical officer (STO) arranges these courses. Please make contact on iascsto@gmail.com to enquire or arrange to be on the next available course. Please see information regarding Technical Officials at the bottom of the page.

If you are interested in helping poolside whether as a poolside helper or as a coach then please speak to any member of the coaching team. The club run a Poolside Helper course occasionally which you may wish to be part of to introduce you to helping the coaches on the pool deck. Swimming Official Roles

Swimming Technical Officials or STOs, like many of our volunteer roles, are central to every swimming event and play an important role in ensuring the events run smoothly, safely and within the sport's regulations. A number of roles exist within officiating, including Timekeeper, Recorder, Judge 1, Judge 2, Judge 2S, Referee and Automatic Officiating Equipment (AOE) Operator.

There are already hundreds of STOs across the country and with the sport continuing to grow, there are lots more opportunities to get involved.

If you are aged 14 years or over, with an interest in swimming – or the enthusiasm to learn, then you have taken the first step to becoming a Swimming Technical Official!

Firstly, you must be a member of a club affiliated to Scottish Swimming so you are insured for your activity on poolside.

TRAINING FEES/BILLING and using MY ACCOUNT SECTION

Training fees and meet entry fees along with any other additional non -recurring payments are charged via Sports Engine. Payments are charged at 00:01 hours on the 1st of every month and we ask that you ensure you have adequate funds in your account at this time. Meet fees are due prior to any meet so may be charged mid-month if the date of the meet falls before the billing date. Any payment information relating to meets will be emailed prior to any charges.

If for any reason any card payments fail then the system will request further payments and if the requests are unsuccessful then Billing will contact the Member to advise them so it can be rectified. Club Training fees also incorporate your membership fees so the club requires these to be kept up to date.

TU recognises when member cards expire so you will be contacted prior to billing to ensure that your card details are updated in advance. Meet entries and caps orders are billed through Sports Engine. Prior to billing, each member due any additional fees will be advised by email that a payment has been raised so invoices can be checked. Details can be checked via the On Deck App or the website.



If your swimmer signs up to any extra training ie race prep sessions. You can view future classes here. Future classes may be registered online or via the organiser. If your swimmer signs up to a class you will receive a confirmation email that your swimmer can attend.





AGREEMENTS

This is a new section and all swimmers sign up to the Code of Conducts when they start. The SE update means that conducts will be resent out for you to agree to and then you will have access to these on your personal account. Watch out for any emails from Membership regarding this.


MEMBERS – You can view all family members registered to the account. Each family has a main account holder with other family members added in the Members Section. Additional email addresses can be added so other families are emailed any club information. Use Alternate Email 1, 2 and 3. Please ensure in the account section that all Guardian and Medical records are updated. Please do not set up the account or main email in the name of the swimmer (if under 18). The main account holder should be a parent or carer.







If you wish your swimmer to compete then choose Attend/Decline










The coaches will approve any swims and if you need to make any amendments or check entries once approved choose Edit Commitment.
