All 5 of our Club based swimmers qualified for at least 1 individual final at either British or English Nationals, which is a fantastic achievement as a group, plus Kam (Swansea Uni) achieving 2 silver medals and then Ayla (Repton) finishing 15th in the 5km Open Water. A fantastic 200 butterfly from Jason at English Nationals saw him break the S14 British Record. This is a massive achievement, and after only getting classified as a Para S14 athlete earlier this year, we're very excited to see what else Jason can produce over the coming years!



We've had almost a month of solid training before we get some racing under our belts at Romford on the 28th/29th September. Then 2 weeks after that we have our 1st home meet of the season at the LAC, and with over 100 NUEL SC swimmers entered, it'll be a busy but inspiring weekend for the Club!

Swimmer & Coach Selections

After some fantastic performances over the summer, a number of NUEL SC National Performance Swimmers have been placed on Swim England Programmes.

Margarita was selected for the National Youth Development Programme. This will see her travel to Loughborough a number of times over the course of the season to train and develop alongside some of the best Youth swimmers in England. Congratulations Magi!

Jason was successful in his application to be part of the Swim England DiSE programme. Over the course of the next two seasons, Jason will also travel to Loughborough for Learning and Training days, and at the end will come away with a Diploma in Sporting Excellence. Congratulations Jason!

Erika is now in her second year of her DiSE programme and will continue her learning and training with Swim England and complete her Diploma this season.

Drew has been selected as a Skills Coach for this year's County and Regional Talent Camps, with this being his second year in both roles. Alongside this, Drew is also one of 30 selected coaches on the yearlong Senior Coach course. Congratulations Drew and good luck!

Home Programme swimmers Rhianna and Jada Yankey have both been selected by the Ghana Swimming Federation to swim for Ghana at the AFRICA AQUATICS ZONE 2 JNR & SNR SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP – ACCRA. They will swim for the Junior Ghana Swimming Team between the 6th and 10th of October. This is a huge achievement for both girls and on behalf of the Club, I'd like to wish them the best of luck!

Finally, after spending the last 2 years as Head Coach of the Regional Talent Programme and Skills Coach on the National Age Group Development Programme (all Talent Programme roles capped at 2 years), I'll be visiting various National Development Programmes to add to my current portfolio and put myself in the best position for selection on National Programmes next season.

Report on NUELSC's Trip to PGL Adventure Holidays, Windmill Hill

We organised a trip to PGL Adventure Holidays at Windmill Hill, East Sussex, for the Newham University of East London Swimming Club (NUELSC). For many members, this was their first time spending a weekend away from home and, for some, their first-time leaving London. This made it an exciting and meaningful experience for everyone involved.

The trip began smoothly, with everyone arriving on time for the bus. The mood on the coach was cheerful, and we had prepared snacks and water for the journey, which kept everyone comfortable. Upon arriving, we were welcomed with a hot meal that helped everyone settle in. Over the weekend, the group enjoyed a variety of fun activities that encouraged team bonding and cooperation. Of course, the kids got some pool time too, but the change in scenery helped them relax and bond in new ways. The coaches also joined in for games of football, basketball, and dodgeball, which helped build rapport between the children and the coaching staff. Sunday 8th September saw a team of 6 members of the squad head over to the Berks & South Bucks County Masters competition in Maidenhead. Despite *just* starting up training again after the club's annual two week summer shutdown, loads of PB's and hardware were won: Beth [GOLDs in the 400 & 800 Free and a SILVER in the 200 Free], Marcus [SILVERs in the 200 IM & 200 Breaststroke and BRONZEs in the 100 Back & 100 Breaststroke, 4th in 200 Back], Alaine [GOLD in 800 Free, SILVER in 100 Back], Hanna [SILVER in 50 & 100 Back, BRONZE in 100 Free, 4th in 50s Free & Fly], Alex [5th in 50 Fly, 8th in 50 Free], Myriam [GOLD in 200 IM, BRONZE in 800 Free]

The following weekend saw lots of open water action on Saturday 14th September with Peter [6 mile] and Alberto [2 mile] swimming their way through the head-up Brea strokers [Peter's description (3)] at **Swim Serpentine** and Megan [3km], James [10km] and Ilya [15km] competing at the **Dock2Dock**

The season opener weekend finished off back in the pool where Cathy & Ewan made their NUEL debuts, alongside Henry, at the **Barnet Copthall Sprint Meet**, coming away with a total of 5 GOLDs [Cathy - 50 Fly & Free, Ewan - 200 & 400 Free, Henry - 50 Fly]


