Lots happening in the Para Swimming community:

Congratulations to Olivia N-B (Maxwell) who, on her return from injury, had some excellent swims at the AGB National Championships in April. During the event Olivia achieved the qualification standard required to be selected to the World Para Swimming Championship Team and has been formally confirmed as part of the team for Singapore in September. A huge achievement and we will be cheering her on every step of the way!

Last weekend saw the regional Para Championships held within the Regional Youth weekend. ONB had 4 representatives taking part and all achieved individual targets. Olivia N-B continued her recovery programme introducing all 4 strokes for the first time since injury and came away with 3 Gold and 2 Silver medals. She also consolidated her position on the AGB Next Gen lists which will form part of her preparation for the World Championships.

Emilie H (Newport Pagnell) had an outstanding debut at Regionals coming away with a Gold and a Silver medal as well as a time placing her on the lists for the AGB Next Gen Competition. She has also achieved the qualification standard for multiple events at English Nationals.

Amanda R (Maxwell) had some solid swims coming away with 1 Silver and 4 Bronze and qualification into English Nationals for all events. Isla R (Maxwell) swimming in her first Regional championship at only 11 years old, acquitted herself brilliantly. She had 2 4th place swims and 4 swims in the top 8, with her 100 backstroke achieving 357 points meaning that she has qualified for English nationals, a fantastic achievement! Next up for Isla and Emilie will be Junior Para Nationals and we wish them well in their events.

A reminder that there is regional training for all swimmers with a disability, including those with hearing impairments and those who are on the waiting list for classification. Regional training is taking place on 1st June at ACS Coham further details can be found here https://www.southeastswimming.org/para-swimming-regional-camp/

Please remember if you have any swimmers who may be eligible for physical classification they will need to attend regional training to have their skills signed off so that they can be placed on the waiting list for classification. If anyone requires any assistance in the process to becoming classified (physical/visual/intellectual) please let me know and I will do my best to support you.

A reminder of dates for your diary - the joint SE/SW development meet is due to take place in Reading on 13th September. If you have swimmers eligible to take part I will ensure you receive the details as soon as they are available and if any officials would like to support and have not yet covered the para training then there is a session running on Thursday 26th June at 7pm on Zoom, the link to sign up is https://forms.swimming.org/para-cpd-june-10694/. This is the same training that has been delivered since June



2023 so if you have done this since then please do not sign up again. The training is free and attracts 3 points towards your license renewal.

Masters

ONB Masters Secretary Report, May 2025

Congratulations to Mike Ireland of 4 Shires SC who broke two County Masters records at the Gloucester Masters Meet on 27 April. Mike swam 34.27 for the 50m backstroke and 5:15.53 in the 400m freestyle to set new records in the men's 60-64 years age group.

Masters swimmers from 4 Shires SC, Aylesbury & District SC, Bourne End SC, City of Oxford SC, Didcot Barramundi SC, Kidlington & Gosford SC and Wantage White Horses SC will be taking part in the British Masters Championships (long course) between 13th-15th June at the London Aquatics Centre.

There are also several local meets coming up during May and June which Masters swimmers may consider entering; at Reading and Swindon on 10 May, Birmingham on 31 May, Hart on 7 June and the AP Race Masters Grand Prix at Winchester on 21-22 June.

I attended a meeting of Masters Representatives from the South East Region counties on 3rd May. At the meeting it was confirmed that the South East Region gala of the National Masters Intercounty Championships will be held on Sunday 9th November at the London Aquatic Centre. As last year, each county has been asked to contribute £500 towards the running of the event, which I hope can be agreed this evening. My successor will be reaching out to all clubs over the summer regarding the event and collating names of swimmers who would wish to be considered for the county team. ONB will also be responsible for providing two officials on the day.

It was also confirmed that from this year onwards, qualifying times drawn from the national rankings database will be required to swim at regional Masters meets, starting with the South East Region Masters at Crawley in the autumn. Therefore, swimmers who wish to swim here will have to have swam the event at another Masters meet within the past two years to ensure their swim is recorded on the rankings database, and achieve the qualifying times set for the event.

Finally, I will be standing down after two years as Masters Secretary at the AGM in July. I would like to thank the Committee for its support and additionally all the Masters swimmers from ONB clubs who have represented the county at Intercounties, especially those who acted as 'point people' for each club in helping to organise the team. The county Masters team has performed admirably over the past few years, and I hope our progress can continue and the county can break into the top 10 counties in the country.

J2 and J2S Officials Training

We've run two training courses since the last Executive Committee. 14 Trainee J2 Officials attended on 1 April and 8 Trainee J2S Officials on 6 May. We wish them well as they now embark on poolside mentoring.

Our waiting list for the next round of courses has been set up.

The administration process for future J2 candidates has been changed again by Swim England. The first stage is an online application form that triggers the payment and ordering of the workbooks, but we still ask that interested trainees <u>complete</u> this form first so we can create our own record of who's interested and we'll advise on next steps.

Swim England has replaced the online Contemporary Issues course that was mandatory for officials licencing. The new Foundation Safeguarding Course (separate ones for under and over 18s) is <u>accessed here</u>. Trainees who have already passed the old course prior to completing their J1s do not need to resit the new course.

Please note that, in line with WavePower, all masters clubs are required to have a welfare officer who has completed the associated training – time to listen course, welfare officer workshop, have a DBS and safeguarding certificate. For those that are struggling to appoint someone to this role, the county welfare officer can be appointed in necessary and agreed.

Coaches working in masters clubs are required to attending safeguarding and have a basic DBS which can be obtained here https://www.gov.uk/request-copy-criminal-record this should be sent to dbs@swimming.org These changes are now mandatory and need to be in place to complete the club affiliation process.

It is advised that, if these are not already in place, that clubs look to do so before their affiliation renewal.

It is also possible to reach out to other regions to request spaces, although these can come with a cost attached.

Please note, those clubs hoping to run camps in the Autum/Winter term should be looking to have a fully trained team of TMs in place already (due to the demand for this course being less, they are run every 2-3 months only). The next TM2 course (required for overnight trips) is in July and members must have their DBS in place, have completed a safeguarding course with Swim England and have attended the TM1 course to attend this course.

This refresher is for swimming teachers, coaches and other personnel working within aquatics activities. It is a mandatory requirement for swimming teachers, coaches and club personnel within Swim England affiliated clubs or activities and is an integral part of the Club Affiliation process.
