Standard Jurisdiction Protocol for Turn Judges (Start and Turn ends of pool)

When at the Start end of the pool with a forward start event - Breaststroke or Butterfly, stand just behind the starting blocks on the long whistle. After the start, step up to the edge of the pool to observe the swimmers in your jurisdiction. Stand in a position that is in the middle of your assigned lanes. If a starting block (diving board) is in the middle, stand to the right of it. At the turn end of the pool, stand in a position that is in the middle of your assigned lanes. When swimmers enter your jurisdiction, step up to the edge of the pool and observe the swimmers. For both the start and turn ends of the pool, once swimmers are out of your jurisdiction, return to your chair and sit down or step back away from the pool's edge if chairs are not available.
