Photography & Social Networking Guidance

Photography and image capture

This guidance applies to all images and videos, which are not suspected of falling under the guidance on indecent/child abuse images of children, taken on any type of camera or recording device (including mobile/smart phones).

It should be acknowledged that although the majority of images taken are appropriate and in good faith, images can be misused, and children can be put at risk if common sense procedures are not observed.

The publishing of a photograph of a member under 18, either on a noticeboard or in a published article or video recording (including video streaming) of a competition ("publication") should only be done with parental consent and in line with Swim England guidelines.

Parents and carers of participants under the age of 18 who wish to take images must focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms. Whilst it is acknowledged that parents/carers wish to celebrate the achievements of their own children when taking part in aquatic events, it should be recognised and respected that other parents/carers may not wish for their child's image to be taken and shared in this way.

We encourage all spectators and participants at these Championship to make themselves familiar with the photography and filming arrangements for the event and be vigilant during that event.

Should individuals have any concerns about photography or filming at the event, this should be brought to the immediate attention of the promoter or county welfare officer who are available throughout the event.

The Swim England guidelines state that all photographs for publication must observe generally accepted standards of decency, particularly:

- Action shots should be a celebration of the sporting activity and not a sexualised image in a sporting context.
- Action shots must not be taken or retained where the photograph reveals a torn or displaced swimming costume.
- Poolside shots of children must be above the waist only in a swimming costume. Full length shots are permitted if the children are fully clothed.
- Photographs must not be taken from behind the starting blocks or that show children climbing in and out of the pool.



Guidance on the use of social networking

There is a growing awareness of the increasing communication between adults and children and indeed their peers on social networking sites.

We recognise that the use of social networking sites such as Facebook, X (formerly Twitter), Instagram, Snapchat, and TikTok, and instant messaging tools such as WhatsApp and Telegram, continue to grow rapidly, and are used as the communication tools of choice by children.

Increasingly, many sites provide a platform for uploading and viewing video clips, which with the latest cameras and mobile phones, becomes ever easier and can be instantaneous. Apps allow mobile phone users to stream content directly from their phones, bypassing some of the steps required in uploading videos to YouTube or to social networks such as Facebook.

Whilst the ever-developing technologies provide exciting opportunities for our members, they are accompanied by dangers and negative consequences if abused by users.

There have been occasions where parents/ guardians of members have used social networking sites to criticise or verbally abuse an organisation, its officers, officials, coaches, teachers, and/or members in an inappropriate and unacceptable manner. This has, in some cases, led the person who is the subject of the abuse to take action through statutory agencies or statutory legislation to address the comments made.

It is recommended that parents/guardians actively monitor their children's online activity, in line with Child Exploitation and Online Protection Command (CEOP) advice, which is proven to help prevent the risks of harm children may face online from peers and others they may know from a club environment.

The ONB Executive Group will treat any derogatory/critical comments towards swimmers, helpers, and officials posted on any social networking site as unacceptable behaviour and will result in that swimmer/club personnel identified as posting/hosting such comments being barred from the remainder of the County Championships without refund.

The ONB Counties A.S.A. are committed to ensuring that all children who participate in county swimming activities are able to take part in an enjoyable, safe environment and be safeguarded from harm. If you have any child safeguarding concerns at the event, please contact an Event Officer immediately to disclose your concerns.
