Para Swimming Championships 2026 Supplement

(S1-S14 Held under Swim England Laws and the World Para Swimming (WPS) Rules of Swimming)

PROMOTERS CONDITIONS SUPPLEMENT

The general conditions for the County Championships and Age Group Competitions 2026 shall apply to the Multi-Classification Para Swimming events except where varied by any of the following conditions:

1. Events:

The above events will take place at Aqua Vale Sports & Leisure Centre in Aylesbury, which has a disability hoist located at the start end of the pool.

Note: Competitors may enter any other events in the County Championships providing they have gained the appropriate qualifying time, but these will not be classed as Multi-Classification Para Swimming events.

2. All competitors (WPS Classification S1-S13) must have an authorised British Swimming or where applicable WPS Swimming Classification, which is held on the British Swimming or WPS Swimming Classification database at the time of entry. Competitors in category S14 must hold or have applied for INAS-Fid or national classification.

Please note that swimmers with an S15 Classification are not eligible to swim in Multi-Classification Para Swimming events as per the Para-Swimming Pathway.

3. All competitors must hold a current WPS Classification at the time of entry.
4. Multi-Classification Para Swimmers must be a member of a Club affiliated to the Oxfordshire & North Buckinghamshire Counties A.S.A. who is eligible within the meaning of Swim England Law and must have been a registered member of the Club in whose name he is entered at least 60 days prior to the first day of competition; 10th January 2026.

Submitted times for all events must have been achieved between 17th February 2025 and 1st December 2025 inclusive, and may be achieved in either a long course or a short course pool. Time Trial times will be permitted providing they have been achieved under appropriate conditions per WPS/Swim England Laws and Technical Rules of Racing. **The closing date for the submission of entries is 3rd December 2025.**

5. A copy of the competitor's WPS Classification from the British Swimming Membership database must be submitted with the swimmer's entry form.



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6. All classes of swimmers will swim together (Multi-Classification Para). The Promoter reserves the right to combine events dependent on the number of entries
7. Should a swimmer with a Para Swimming Sport Classification swim a time in integrated heats that qualifies them for the relevant Age Group or Open Final, they should not be debarred from competing in that Final.
8. Results will be calculated as recommended by the WPS.
9. Awards will be presented to the top three for each Multi-Classification Para event. Presentation will take place at the end of the session.
10. Multi-Classification Para-Swimmers will be judged under the relevant WPS Swimming Rules.
