

Parent's Code of Conduct

1. I will register my member/s with PSC Team Unify and complete all Medical Information requested by Putteridge Swimming Club hereinafter referred to as PSC. I undertake to provide details of any health conditions/concerns/medications relevant to my child/children on Team Unify in the relevant Medical section. I will further undertake to report any changes in the state of my child's health to the Coach prior to training sessions or events. I will ensure that the Organisation has **TWO** up-to-date Emergency Contact details as required and listed in PSC 'Team Unify'.
2. I will always behave responsibly as a spectator during training/events and treat members, coaches, committee members and other parents of members of both PSC and any other organisation with due respect, in accordance with the Swim England's Commitment to Equality and Diversity.
3. If PSC changes my child's lane/training times/training programme or any other aspect of training, I accept that these changes are in the best interest of my child/children to help provide the appropriate levels of training and to help enable progress. I fully support and encourage this.
4. I will ensure to read all communications via email, website notifications or otherwise from PSC and respond if requested in accordance with the communication and within the time constraints set out in each specific communication.
5. I will deliver and collect my child punctually to and from training sessions/events. I will inform a member of the Committee or coaching staff if there is any unforeseen circumstance that might cause a delay.
6. In the event my child cannot attend any training session, function or event in which they are expected to attend, I will advise PSC promptly.
7. I will ensure my child is physically fit and well enough to attend training, properly and adequately attired for the training session/events including all mandatory equipment, e.g. hats, goggles, etc.
8. I will inform the Coach/Welfare Officer: welfare@putteridgesc.co.uk before a session if my child is to be collected early from a training session/event and if so, by whom.
9. I will endeavour to pay all Monthly and Entry Fees due on time.
10. I will encourage my child to obey the rules and teach them that they can only do their best.
11. I will ensure that I abide by the club's [Social Media Policy](#) and will not communicate any comment of any kind on Facebook, Twitter or any other form of Social Media that may damage or negatively affect the name and/or reputation of PSC.
12. I understand that any derogatory comments posted on social networking or in writing or made verbally to any person during or following my child's/childrens membership of PSC will be considered defamatory if it contains any untruth and/or serves to undermine or damage the reputation of PSC, appropriate action will be taken which may result in expulsion from PSC, or in the event that you are

no longer members, further action will be considered.

13. I will not use inappropriate language within the club environment.
14. I will show appreciation and support for my child and all PSC team members.
15. I will ensure that my child's needs are met in terms of nutrition and I will listen to advice given from the Coach/Nutritionist.
16. I will support the Coach and Committee appropriately and raise any concerns I may have in an appropriate manner to the Welfare Officer welfare@putteridgesc.co.uk.
17. I will not enter poolside unless requested to do so or in an emergency.
18. If I wish to have a discussion with the Coach, I will check with the Welfare Officer welfare@putteridgesc.co.uk as to how this can be arranged.
19. I understand that poor behaviour, in any form, may result in the club taking disciplinary action.
20. Most of all, I will help my child to enjoy the sport and to achieve to the best of their ability.
21. PSC undertakes to:
 - a. Inform you at once if your child becomes ill and will ensure their wellbeing until you are able to collect him/her.
 - b. Ensure good child safeguarding guidelines are followed at all times to keep your child safe.
 - c. Ensure all activities are properly supervised/ taught/coached and that consent is obtained for any activity outside of that previously agreed.
22. You have a right to:
 - a. Make a complaint to the organisation if you feel that PSC or a member of PSC is not acting appropriately or in accordance with Swim England organisation rules and regulations. Details of how to do this can be obtained from the Welfare Officer.
 - b. Make a complaint on behalf of your child to the Swim England Office of Judicial Administration.
