Welcome, Introductions & Housekeeping:

AS welcomed the Network and gave an overview of the success of AS swimmers since the last meeting. Performance and achievement going well. Attended 2 Level 2 meets and achieved top visiting club at both meets. Many club records have been broken.

We are losing around £5000 per month as we do not have enough swimmers especially in the regional squad approx 22 short. Model is not sustainable beyond the second quarter isf support from Network does not improve, As we have financial issues we cannot afford Lawrie to go out to clubs he is needed to coach therefore we laid on tonights 'meet the coach'only 2 clubs attending. Did not replace Liam when he left & we have fewer volunteer coaches from the Network Attendance from the Network Clubs at Open Meets is not good. If the November meet goes ahead the profit will be down.

We need the Network Clubs to engage and contribute to AS becoming a success not only in the pool.

6. Constitution changes: agreed by Network that the Constitution proposed and circulated to all clubs will not work and allow AS to work on a day to day basis. Mainly because all clubs do not communicate or return requests for comment. This is acknowledged as difficult as we are all volunteers but some decisions will need to be taken quickly for the smooth running of the club and for the swimmers who are members. As to maintain communication and advise Network on any changes.

Amended constitution to be sent to Alan Withers for advice and approval before it can be voted on at the AGM.

- **7. Recruitment** into AS: to date only 1 swimmer from Trowbridge. Lindsay asked why this was as there were swimmers who should be recommended. Keynsham said most preferred COB because of distance and accessibility. Note from Keynsham:
- 'At the present time we have no swimmers, who are not already swimming at ASPSC or COB, ready to progress to Performance swimming we continue to support both COB and AS.

BoA no swimmers, Bath Dolphins would only support the Elite pro gramme no other squads.

Lawrie at Lindsay's suggestion to go through ASA rankings and see if there are potential swimmers who should be referred by Network Club.

8. Open Meets: November meet we need more officials and not well attended by Network clubs-main reason being the qualification times being more difficult. Licensing of future meets dependent on this being a success. Level 1 in March tbc, Level 3 in April tbc.

9. Update from the Network Clubs

ASA Vision



- To get more people swimming provide opportunities for people to swim at all levels
- Responsibility is to our members hence the need to provide opportunities, limit the 'lottery postcode effect'
- Club team: aim to develop sustainable club structures that offer competitive opportunities at all levels
- Talent team: aim to ensure that there are clear 'performance' pathways for swimmers with the aspirations and capabilities; squads are a dying breed!

Competitive Swimmers



- 1) Those who aspire and have the capability Performance Pathway
- 2) Those who aspire but perhaps lack the capability

 Club Pathway Performance Pathway? Club Pathway may make performance standards in earlier years, then revert back into club programmes which need to cater for their ongoing aspirations
- 3) Those who lack the aspiration but have the capability

 Club Pathway Performance Pathway?, there is an obvious need to keep the performance pathway option 'on the table' as aspirations often change with maturity/ development

 Need to ensure that club programmes can continue to progress the athlete to enable
 - them to transition into the performance pathway at a later stage if desired

The Facts!



- We need a performance programme to support the 'talent' pathway in Bath and the surrounding area
- The programme has historically contributed a number of swimmers to the England and GBR Junior and Senior International teams:

Siobhan Marie – O'Connor Stacey Tadd

- None of our local 'network' clubs have the current capacity to deliver a national youth programme ... (16 hours water time)
- Aquae Sulis, in it's current format is not sustainable!

Options ...



- Maintain the status quo
 - + ve: retain control over the programme and retain it's identity
 - ve: tarnished reputation and complete reliance on buy in from network clubs and income from open meets
- Consider a relationship with Bath University
 - + ve: funded fully/ partially by the University, more sustainable
 - ve: would need assurances long term
- Consider a relationship with a local club/ clubs
 - + ve: underpinning club structures could sustain the performance end of the programme and a possible 'complete' swimmer pathway in Bath
 - ve: ????
