### **Club Development and Workforce**

Meeting with Somerset ASA- Fiona Bowen and Alan Withers will visit us on 2<sup>nd</sup> march at 6.45pm to discuss the changes at the club and progress for the future year and that of the network. Invited are Sean, Adrian, Julia, Karen. Please let me know whether you wish to attend this informal discussion.

ASA Coaching Swimming Assistant Course starting this weekend with 16 candidates. The course has sold out.

STV reception staff advised of names to get access to poolside and parents informed of details.

This Saturday will need someone to cover collection of land training kit and ensuring swimmers make it to poolside at Mike will need to attend his course promptly at 9.30am.

**ASA Coaching Swimming Level 2** course details booked but not confirmed yet from IOS about whether it will be blended learning. To stay in contact with James Paramore.

**ASA Coaching Swimming Level 3**- no details released at present or pricing.

**ASA Coaching Swimming Level 1 course-** advised that there would be enough numbers to run a course in late September/ October 2017. Awaiting to see if this would be through blended learning then find a tutor.

**Team Manager 1 module** running on the 10<sup>th</sup> March with Chris Metcalfe as the presenter. We can have up to 20 people. Need to advertise in the news section of the website and on twitter. Details to be sent to the ASA SW region and Somerset ASA by beginning of next week. Advise that coaches are enrolled where possible so that they can progress to TM2.

Team Manager 2 module for away camps and going abroad delayed until feedback on overseas camp.

Officials Training- Thank you to Michele Greenan for arranging a J1 course. 5 people turned up (I think 2 that we had recommended) and 3 were unable to attend. J2 course details were found with very short notice to Nikki. She was attending the training at Calne. Not sure if we are receiving all invites direct-may contact the officials trainers to ask if they could send me any details direct.

**Doping workshop-** 100%me, anti doping awareness awaiting confirmation of a date when Rachel Burrows is able to visit Bath. She is the programme manager at Loughborough.

**Nutrition course** for training and competition- need to speak to Chris Alderton about whether he has anyone in mind or perhaps contact Renee McGregor.

Based on a conversation with Chris I will leave it to him to let me know what he wants to do for the future as it is his programme.

Other course to consider are: Role of a swimming parent-Swimmer pathway and Competition preparation.

To discuss feedback from clubs regarding development lanes on Sundays and whether we can apply for network funding before the end of March 2017.

Lap cards- Somerset hade their own lap cards which are available for any Somerset club. They only have 8 though so we will need some from another club or Wiltshire if we are to run 10 lanes. The Somerset lap cards are currently with Julia.

Officials expenses policy- draft policy sent to Adrian, Sue and Nikki for feedback prior to bring before the committee for approval.

## **Team Bath AS Policy for Swimming Officials Expenses**

We would like to thank all officials who attend our meets. They help to ensure that swimmers have the opportunity to compete at the appropriate level. We rely on your generosity in giving up your time and it is greatly appreciated. This is our policy on expenses for officials at our meets.

If you are the parent or carer of a swimmer that is competing in any event you will only be entitled to expenses if you officiate for the whole day. If you have completed <u>all</u> sessions during a day you will be entitled to half your mileage allowance as long as your journey is over 1 hour.

**Day Refreshments**: At all competitions that cover more than one session during the day refreshments will be provided (but please bring a water bottle poolside).

### **MILEAGE**

Mileage will be checked and verification may be requested before payment is made.

Payment for mileage will be made at an agreed current rate set by ASA South West (2017 current rate of 45p per mile) and will normally be between home address and the venue. If the journey starting point differs from the home address payment will be made for whichever is the shorter distance.

Mileage is paid for officials who work for the whole day.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

Applicable to open events run by Team Bath AS with consecutive days. Maximum claim 1 night per weekend or 2 nights if working 3 days.

- 1. Officials must work for the whole weekend for 1 night claim, or 2 consecutive days if a 3 day competition. Two nights may be claimed if working the whole 3 days.
- 2. Journey must be in excess of 1 hour.
- 3. Accommodation to be shared where possible.
- 4. Officials who accompany competitors or other persons may claim 50% of the costs on production of a receipt providing other conditions are met.

Accommodation costs will be considered for those who make a request to the meet organiser and it is approved in advance. It is essential that the club know who this applies to as budgets need to be monitored.

Officials will need to book their own accommodation and make a claim for re-imbursement on production of a receipt if approval is given.

The maximum allowance is £80 for a shared double/twin room or £60 single.

### **EVENING MEAL**

This is normally only paid for those who have approval for overnight accommodation. A detailed receipt **must** be attached to the claim form. Current rate is a maximum of £17.50 per night (alcohol cannot be included).

NB. Those who fulfil club duties requested by the Events Management Secretary are not entitled to claim expenses. Trainee Officials cannot claim expenses.
