### **Fundraising report June 2018**

1. **300 Club** – I have sent off the application to BANES to obtain a license in order to legally carry out the monthly draws. Hoping to hear back within a couple of weeks.

Then I will produce the tickets for each member's parents/guardians to sell to family and friends.

Suzanne, can you send me a list of all current swimmers please, so I can allocate tickets.

For those that want to know how the draw works, see below.....

Each individually numbered ticket costs £10 to buy.

Hoping to get each Swimmers Parent/Guardian to sell 5 tickets each (To family and friends)

This £10 ticket entitles you to be entered into 10 separate monthly draws running from August 2018 to May 2019. (£1 a month effectively)

Example: if we have 60 swimmers Parents / Guardians selling 5 each, that's 300 tickets at a total of £3,000 income.

We'll then take £1,000 of that income to distribute in prizes each month. (10 months x £100)

Breakdown of prizes each month for randomly drawn numbers will be...

1<sup>st</sup> Prize £50

2<sup>nd</sup> Prize £25

3<sup>rd</sup> Prize £15

4th Prize £10

This will leave £2,000 profit for the club (In theory!)

- 2. **Team Bath Open Meet** June  $30^{th}$ , July  $1^{st} I$  will send out an email this week asking for raffle prize donations to sell tickets for over the weekend
- 3. Quiz Night I would like the committee's opinion on whether we think this is an option or not.

I've made an initial enquiry into hiring a hall for such an event. My personal opinion is that this could be a successful annual event, almost as a curtain raiser to the season starting in September. Saturday nights I feel is the only option due to training schedules. Would be a good opportunity for teams to be made up of swimmers and parents, family and friends etc.

On the night, we can hold a raffle, provide food and also we may have the opportunity to run our own bar! (This could prove to be very profitable)
