• Key Objective 1

- Work to develop and improve the quality of Coaching at Home Clubs by;
- The provision of Network Club Coaches workshops and training events
- Setting up a network coach mentoring scheme for level 1 and level 2 coaches
- Visiting all the Network Clubs to review their programme of coaching and provide feedback and support
- Specific targets
- Run: 2 X Coaches Meetings per annum.-agreed to run 2 coaches meetings per annum to coincide with the network meeting
- Promote regional workshops and educational opportunities
- Visit each Network Club at least once per season.
- Additional visits as requested by Hub club.
- Who will be responsible?
- Head Coach supported by Training & Development Manager & network coaches
- Network clubs
- Actions:
- Workshops and forums information is provided by Emily and Lindsay. This
 is sent directly to clubs or to the network to distribute to the network.
- Arrange when coaches meetings are to be held. This has done at the end of network meetings. In November it was held poolside and only 2 coaches attended (Chippenham and Norton Radstock). Could we book dates in advance.
- Coaches are invited to attend poolside to any training session. This also includes Strength and Conditioning sessions. Timetable is available on the website. This can also occur between clubs. Advice from previous courses is that it is good to attend prior to a qualification to gain knowledge of the environment, swimmers and programme.
- Coaches should be encouraged to visit programme once a year and AS aim to visit all network clubs (12 weeks per year at one a week).
- Update from April meeting

- At the April meeting Chris still to visit Calne and Keynsham
- CA wishes to strengthen communication. This will be ongoing as a blended performance pathway. Will look after any Network swimmer at Regionals/Nationals if wanted by clubs.
- Will reinstate Coaches meetings to run alongside the Network meeting- to be actioned from September and/or Emily to set up an online meeting forum for coaches.
- Update from July meeting
- Backstroke Coaching Masterclass run by Graeme Anthwhistle on June 3rd at a cost Network Clubs of £10 This was subsidized by the SW regional Swimming Committee. SOLD OUT- Attended by 19 coaches plus our coaching staff poolside. Fiona Bowen also visited that day and was able to see the network in action. Positive feedback from participants combining classroom with poolside activities.
- Information about regional workshops, opportunities and forums have been distributed to the network via club contact given to Team Bath AS

Key Objective 2

- Provide workshops and training events for Network Club officials and Committee Members.
- Specific Targets
- Conduct an annual network Training Needs Analysis and decide what workshops need to be delivered. This will be reviewed twice a year.
- Who will be responsible?
- Network clubs with the support of the ASPSC workforce officer and the ASA Club Development Officer.
- Actions:
- The year is spit into 2 groups: Sept- March then Feb-August
- Request for training requirements to be sent to clubs in July for coming season.
- To fill courses we need:
- 20 places for Safeguarding courses
- 16 for a Level 1 course
- 12-14 for a level 2
- Team managers up to 20 people
- Officials: as many as possible as courses are never full. Keynsham and Trowbridge continue to organise.
- Aim: to train more team manager presenters of module 1 and module 2
- If we travel abroad do we open up to experienced team mangers from the network.
- Promote Club Matters Guides: what are clubs missing
- Continue to promote Young Volunteer programmes.
- Update for July meeting- Courses provided since December 2016
- Officials course, J1 by Chris Metcalfe. Somerset ASA paid for the room hire with 11 candidates attending both workshops: 6 from Somerset and 5 from Wiltshire. COURSE FULL 20th June and 4th July 2017

- Team Manager 1 course provided by Chris Metcalfe on 11th March 2017 attended by 16 people
- Safeguarding and Protecting Children Course rn in December 2016 with 14 attendees
- New SWIM ENGLAND Coaching Assistant course (level 1) SOLD OUT with 16 candidates attending in Feb/ March 2017
- New SWIM ENGLAND Coaching Assistant course (Level1) 9 candidates on the blended learning course in June 2017
- Upcoming Course
- NEW Swim England Swimming Coach qualification Blended learning starting 4th August 2017- advertised to region at a club offer price of £510

- Aim to send out a calendar at least in advance of the coming season. This should cover events that are targeted for the performance club covering at least up until January then plans for the full yeat.
- Club template of events would help clubs support each other with officials, enable swimmers to see friends, help clubs support each other with officials and income from meets, identify were skills were lacking?
- It also helps England Programmes see the number of events and leagues our swimmers take part in and the level of swimmers attending.

- Open Meet info: qualifying times harder in the South West region: Lindsay Lindsay/Adrian Dunn to investigate.
- Competition policy-agreed that this will run with the new squad structure and will be part of the criteria to be presented in July. There may be different policies for different clubs. What is right for the swimmers is the priority.
