<u>Treasurer's Report – Committee Meeting 08/12/2018</u>

As I have just taken over from Helen, I am still getting to grips with what is in the accounts and over the next few weeks I will get a better understanding of the workings of the club (so far I have just been a parent (with officiating duties)).

I have attached the Profit & Loss Report and Balance Sheet as of 30/11/18. However we are still waiting on the invoice from the University for November's fees (Helen has chased and provided my contact details to them).

The Profit for the period 01/09/18-30/09/18 stands at £10,692 (but please remember this does not include the University invoice).

I will be reviewing the memberships and fees with Suzanne over the next few weeks to ensure all the income is being accounted for and where necessary catch up invoices sent out to parents of swimmers.

The attached Balance Sheet shows as of the 30/11/18 we had £59354 cash in the bank. The overall worth of the club is £57918 (again this does not reflect the University fees for November).

Club Development/ Workforce December 2018 Update

Volunteers:

All our members whether paid or volunteers are made Team Bath AS members- there is a cost involved. They then need the correct qualifications and checks some with costs again. All need signing of code of conduct and input onto the membership and Team Bath system. Also need to be given and understand appropriate policies and risk assessments and have contact details for swimmers in their care, if appropriate. Suzanne has the fees for Swim England membership from Jan 2018.

I have been receiving responses from volunteers following the AGM. I have attached a not fully complete spreadsheet showing the commitments so far. This does not include the Academy parents who are also stepping forward as I need more time to complete the recruitment. Please keep the list **CONFIDENTIAL** at this stage- awaiting discussion.

Training Centre- Team Bath has been Awarded Approved Training Status by the Institute of Swimming- the certificate needs putting on the website. Check with Karen and Chris H. **Swim England Coaching Swimming assistant course** (level 1): Rhiannon, Amy and Megan attended. Thank you to the tutor Michelle Jones as well as the swimmers and coaches over the weekend.

Safeguarding and Protecting Children Course- Saturday 24th November, 17 attended at a cost of £20 per place compared to usually cost of £42. We have 5 places from our club and several others have been advised to find course to attend so that they can continue their volunteering and coaching role. Will claim the excess of any course over the £20 from Somerset ASA and this will be invoiced to the region. Many thanks to Steve Boocock for presenting the course. We are awaiting certificates which will be emailed to candidates and an invoice before we can try and claim some funding from Somerset ASA.

800m/1500m funding- Swimming Committee funding application accepted and report sent to Chris Tremellen. Awaiting final funding response- application resubmitted for £372.74 **Communication email** sent to academy parents so can know about non-attendance and answer other general enquiries.

Parent meeting- 8th December 11.30am to 12pm, specific parents to be held by Chris. **Academy** separate- parent and Swimmer meeting, first week in Janu if possible, enquiring about rooms

Christmas Sessions: Currently sending out the Christmas sessions to all squads **Lifeguarding Course**: details from the University sent out to all the club for February half term qualification.

Young Volunteers program- 2 volunteers form Norton Radstock helped at our meet and certificates and thank you sent to Kelly Podbury and the volunteers.

Colin Christmas has been invited to visit the club- write up on Somerset ASA news and twitter **Xmas Social** Many thanks to Ann Cookson for arranging the arranging the evening on 24th November at Holt Village Hall. To follow up on the finance report with Ann.

Masters Swimming Program The aim is to get 12 swimmers by the end of the financial year. Good progress thanks to Guy with numbers increasing. This will be helped with more advertising and the business cards. Aim to send Somerset a report and request further funding from the region from January. They will consider an entry for relays at Somerset and are looking at the viability of a first meet in Gloucester. Although Guy has been running the program as it grows there will be a need to feedback or give updates or a representative on the committee? He may give feedback on the photography policy for masters swimmers.

Upcoming events to build the club and recruit new volunteers need to be considered.Helping with these events is how many people have been recruited as they see it as a fun way to get involved with raising money.





Events available are Swimathon, and Comic Relief. I have asked for details on all of these.

These are especially good for the Academy and masters programs to feel connected to the rest of the club. They are not competing in events for us and the Academy can take certificates into schools for assemblies. The parents can easily help by counting laps or giving out certificates and we can raise money for good causes. This then means for Swimathon we can access applications to Swimathon funding plus approach companies and ask for a donation either match funded or because we are helping communities- we have had donations for doing this in the past. To get a parent involved is easier and once they see it is not complicated and meet people they are found to be likely to engage in volunteering posts in the future- long term parent/ volunteer development just like the swimmers. It does work. We get lots of promotion and can send it to Somerset, the region and Swimming times or Chronicle.
