<u>Treasurer's Report – Committee Meeting June 2019</u>

I have attached the Profit & Loss Report and Balance Sheet as of 31.05.19

The accounts show a loss for the period 01/09/18-31/05/19 of £14,370.00 for the first 9 months of this financial year.

The attached Balance Sheet shows as of the 31/05/19 we had £6,711 cash in the bank. The overall worth of the club is £32.956.00.

For the balance sheet prepayments, accruals and income in advance figures – please see attached for the breakdown.

All invoices to swimmers have been raised where necessary for either fees, kit or meets. Statements have been sent out to all accounts where there is any overdue money.

All invoices received for the month had been included in the accounts. Monies received for our June meet and invoices/costs for the COB meet for July are all included in the balance sheet under income in advance and prepayments.

For approval from the committee is the budget for 2019/20 season, the income is based on a new fee structure below and the current swimmers we have plus an additional 30 swimmers at 1 sessions per week for the Academy Academy

1 session £45
Start (2 sessions) £60
Turn (2 sessions) £60
Finish (2 sessions) £60
Finish (3 sessions) £70

Main Squads (Age Potential/Youth Potential/Transition/Performance)

Masters based on current swimmers and the fees they pay, plus an additional 5 swimmers at 1 session per week (£20).

With the fee increases and the potential new swimmers we should achieve a profit for the season of around £5000. I don't believe we have any other choice but to increase these fees – the increase reflects the 9% cost increase we have to absorb from the University and so the costs are basically just being passed onto the swimmers at roughly the same % - so very justified for us to be able to continue.

The budget includes the Horfield meet plus 4 meets with Millfield (with a base profit of \$4000 per meet).

The budget needs approval for the Swim21 accreditation (copy of the form format for this has been attached with the report).

I am showing Stephanie the Xero software in July but feel we would still be best to get another volunteer to do the Treasurer role, as due to Steph's swimming commitments I am not convinced she will have enough time to dedicate to the role as it will be imperative for these to be kept up to date in order for the new committee (whomever they maybe) to be able to keep the club going in the right direction.





I am more than happy to train any new treasurer on the software and the spreadsheets I have set up and will be happy to be a sounding board for the first few months after the role has been taking over but would really like to have someone trained and in place ready for the AGM.
