Letter from the committee and treasurer

Dear Member,

As the 2022/2023 season is concluding, we would like to thank our swimmers and their families for being part of the CWSC community and making this season the success it has been. The club has been operating at full capacity with: busy training schedules; numerous competitions; and training camps. This has translated into impressive achievements at County, Regional, National and International events.

We have definitely not been immune to rising operating costs. However, due to the squad fee increases implemented last September, the club remains viable and sustainable; and continues to deliver high quality training and competition programs.

In light of the above, the Board of Directors has voted to maintain squad fee rates with no change for the next season. Therefore, your monthly fees from September 2023 will continue at the current level.

Last year we expanded our Bursary assistance program to include scholarships that reward performance, dedication and commitment in our swimmers' journey. With that in mind, please see below a reminder of how you can support the club's fundraising initiatives.

In order to succeed, a swimming club requires: coaches; pools; and, most importantly, swimmers. We have a fantastic, world class coaching team; and the recent Club Championships and Mini Club Championships have shown that we have a diverse, dynamic and energetic group of swimmers. We remain very optimistic and confident about the future of the Club.

CWSC 2023/2024 Fundraising

One of CWSC's priorities is to ensure that swimming is an inclusive sport within our diverse community; no swimmer should be barred from progressing on the competitive pathway due to their financial circumstances. As a not-for-profit

organisation, run primarily by volunteers, fundraising is essential to achieve this priority.

This season we have been able to fundraise through initiatives such as the very popular Olympic Series clinics, and also the voluntary monthly contributions generously made by Members. Fundraising initiatives like these enable us to offer Bursary support to swimmers as well as offering Performance Scholarships.

We would like to remind you of the initiative set up in 2021 where members can contribute a specific monthly amount. For example, 11 members each contributing £10 monthly would cover a Bursary swimmer in Black Hats for a year; 10 members each contributing £20 monthly would cover the bursary fees for a National Performance swimmer for a year.

Members who are interested in supporting this fundraising initiative can sign up to contribute a specific monthly amount in one of two ways:

- 1. Emailing <u>treasurer4@cwswimming.com</u> specifying the account name and monthly contribution amount. Or
- 2. Logging in to your account, signing up for the Fundraising Team Event on our website and specifying the monthly contribution amount in the comment box. It is similar to how you sign up for competitions.

Fundraising contributions will be automatically billed to your payment card monthly in addition to your squad fees and other club charges. If you change your mind, you can cancel your future monthly contributions at any point by emailing treasurer4@cwswimming.com.

Support for CWSC from our Members comes in many forms and we would like to thank every one of you that has contributed to the life and community of the Club.
