



Club Etiquette and General Conduct Rules applicable to all members and related parties

- To display a high standard of behaviour at all times and to understand you are representing West Suffolk Swimming Club at any venue when training (land or water based), at competitions, at any Club based social activity or other Swim England activity.
- Swimmers should not take phones or other photographic equipment (cameras, tablets etc) into changing areas.
- Everybody should be encouraged to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- Everybody should refer all child safeguarding concerns in accordance with the procedures detailed in Wavepower.
- If a child is to be collected at a venue other than by the usual parent/carer, the coach/team manager at that venue must be informed in advance.
- Parents will ensure their child/children's nutritional needs are met and will listen to any advice given to them by the coach/nutritionist.
- Coaches and Pool Support personnel will cooperate with any third party specialists (eg. Coaches, physiotherapists etc) to ensure the best interests of the member.
- Everybody will never encourage or condone the violation of rules of WSSC or the sport and any such violations will be reported appropriately.
