Last weekend (15 and 16 October) saw a contingent of younger West Suffolk swimmers from training centres in Haverhill, Bury St Edmunds and Culford compete at the Suffolk County Development meet in Ipswich. This is the second time the event has been held since the Covid pandemic and the first since supporters and spectators were able to enjoy the action live on poolside at Crown Pools.

The Suffolk County Development meet is an inclusive competition for swimmers aged 9 to 15+ and the West Suffolk team was delighted to come away with a haul of 75 medals across all age groups. In total the team won 20 gold medals, 26 silver medals and 29 bronze medals.
