NEW YEAR MEET - CONDITIONS

ENTRIES

- The competition will be swum under Swim England rules and Technical Rules
- All swimmers must be Swim England registered with 'Club Compete' membership and provide a membership number.
- The female category is for birth sex females only in accordance with Swim England's
 Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer
 confirms their birth sex is female.
- All entries must meet the qualifying criteria and therefore not be faster than the upper limit times. There are no minimum qualifying times, however we ask for all swimmers to submit an entry time, either from rankings, club time trials, or training – any entries wit NT (no time) will not be accepted.
- All times must have been achieved since 1st January 2025
- All events will be seeded on time
- All events will be swum as Heat Declared Winners with all heats spearheaded
- Entries may be restricted to keep the session times within appropriate timescales. Acceptance cannot be guaranteed. Details of accepted and rejected entries will be published on our website as soon as possible after the closing date.
- Classified Para-Swimmers will be also be able to enter the meet, however there will NOT be separate multi-classification results, these swimmers will be shown in their own age-groups.
- The cost of entry is £8.00 per event via Sportsystem. (£9.00 for paper entries or non- SS entries).
- Entries will be open from 1st September 2025 and the Sportsystem entry file can be accessed and downloaded here:
- A designated club officer must make all club entries and that same person must make all communications to the meet organiser.
- Age groups are as follows: 9/10yrs, 11/12yrs, 13/14yrs, and 15/Over (Age on day midnight on 4th January 2026)
- The closing date for entries is midnight Sunday 21st December entries will be accepted in a **first come first served basis** after Repton entries have been processed.

OFFICIALS

- Clubs with more than 10 or more swimmers entered in the meet are requested to provide a minimum of one official for all sessions in which the club has entered
- Names and contact details for the officials should be completed by the person responsible for submitting the entries and forwarded together with the confirmation of entries.
- All officials/volunteers who support the meet with be provided with refreshments upon arrival, plus food during both the session breaks. Any official who is required to make the meet compliant and undertakes a full day of officiating duties AND does not have a child entered in the meet, may also be provided with travel expenses of 45p/mile. Expense forms can be provided by contacting the Meet Manager

POOLSIDE PASSES

- Poolside passes will cost £20.00 each and will include access to the poolside and sports hall, heat sheets, results, and food/refreshments
- Clubs are asked to send a list of Coaches / Team Managers to the meet promotor before the event
- In order to meet SE safeguarding requirements, all Coaches / Team Managers attending will be required to download the 'Free SE DBS/Safeguarding Qualifcation Check' from Swim England Member Options Event Accreditation | Swim England (swimmingresults.org) and present this qualification upon arrival in order to collect their poolside pass.
- Please note that if a chaperone is required then please contact the Meet Director directly

SWIMMER SUPERVISION

- In order to meet the SE supervision policy, please ensure all clubs meet the current SE ratio guidelines
- If you are an individual entry, these guidelines also apply, meaning a Level 2 Coach and Team
 Manager should accompany the swimmer however if this isn't possible, individual swimmers
 should aim to 'buddy up' with another visiting club (please see the accepted entry list for
 assistance)

RESULTS

- Medals will be awarded to the top-3 swimmers in each age group (as stated) in each individual event.
- A Top Boy and Top Girl Award will be presented the swimmer in each age-group who accumulates the highest number of points (1st = 10pts / 2nd = 9pts / 3rd = 8pts / 4th = 7pts / 5th = 6pts / 6th = 5pts / 7th = 4pts / 8th = 3pts / 9th = 2pts / 10th = 1pt)
- All results will appear on Swim England Rankings after the meet, plus online here:
- The closing date for entries is midnight Sunday 21st December entries will be accepted in a first come first served basis after Repton entries have been processed.





GENERAL

- The Meet will be held at Repton Sports Centre, Willington Road DE65 6FH. The centre has 6 lane 25m pool. Electronic timing with scoreboard will be used. There will be a secondary strobe available for hearing impaired swimmers.
- Swim meet entries will be managed via computer and available via the internet. By submitting
 entries, consent is thereby given, as required under the Data Protection Act 1984, to the holding
 of personal information on a computer. Personal data, including submitting and recorded times,
 will be publicly available during the meet
- When not in the pool or marshalling area, swimmers will be based in the sports hall. Access to the sports hall will be for swimmers, coaches, and team managers only.
- Repton Sports Centre has an on-site coffee shop that will be open throughout the event
- All competitors shall always observe the rules of Repton Sports Centre and comply with any instructions given by staff.
- Repton Sports Centre and Repton Swimming shall not be responsible for the loss or damage to any property.
- During warm-ups, swimmers and coaches must ensure that they take no action that would endanger themselves or others. Swimmers should swim in the direction indicated. Sprint Lanes will be announced during warm up.
- Anything not covered by these rules shall be at the discretion of the meet organisers.
- Spectator seating is available and limited to 130, spectator fee TBC.
