PROMOTER'S CONDITIONS

- The competition is licensed by Swim England for entry into County and Regional Competitions, and Open Meets at Licence Level 1 and Level 2. All events will be conducted in accordance with Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing.
- 2. Competitors must be registered as Club Compete with their governing body, eligible to compete and registered in accordance with British Swimming Laws and Technical Rules and may enter in the name of one club only.
- 3. The Competition will be run as an integrated competition. Para-Swim/Disability competitors must have an authorised disability Classification, or Certificate of Disability/Exception which must be declared on the entry form and be presented to the Referee at the start of the relevant session before racing commences. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- 4. Upper Cut-Off Times apply to this meet. Any swimmer who, at the closing date of entries for the Meet, has achieved a time faster than the published upper limit may not enter that event. Should it transpire at any stage that a swimmer has submitted an ineligible entry then that the entry will be rejected, and the fee forfeited.
- 5. Entries for this meet will be accepted in the order in which each Club entry is received on a First-Come First-Served basis. Entries will close once the swimmer capacity limit has been reached or on the specified closing date, whichever is the sooner. Entries open on Saturday 1st March at 8.00 am and close at midnight on Tuesday 25th March; no entries will be accepted before the opening date for submission. In the event that any session is still oversubscribed rejections will be made on submitted time from the last accepted Club entry only. No changes will be accepted after the specified closing date to enable heats to be finalised and information sent to all clubs attending.

ENTRIES

- 5. a) The entry fee will be £9.00 per event.
 - b) Entries comprising more than five swimmers must be made electronically.
 - c) Entries will not be accepted without the purchase of a Coach Pass; Seagulls SC cannot be responsible for unaccompanied swimmers.
 - d) Club entries should be submitted using the Hy-Tek Team Manager electronic entry system (download available via https://hytek.active.com/swim-meet-software.html) and full details of how to enter are available via the SSC website at www.seagullsswimming.club
 - e) All entries, associated paperwork, and a single online payment made to Seagulls SC must be received by the specified closing date of midnight on Saturday 25th March 2025 at the email address provided at the end of these conditions.
 - f) Late or illegible entries may not be accepted.
 - g) The correct entry fees must accompany entries, or those entries will not be accepted.
 - h) All entries must comply with the upper time limits.





- i) A list of accepted entries will be made available prior to the Meet. It is the responsibility of the club representative to check all entries for correct name spelling, age, and entry times. Any errors must be reported to the Meet Co-ordinator by the date specified once this information is made available. Notification of discrepancies by the date specified does not guarantee that a discrepancy can or will be corrected.
- j) Improved entry times will not be accepted after the official closing date regardless of the date of achievement.
- k) No refunds will be made for withdrawals after the official closing date unless on medical grounds. The Meet Co-ordinator MUST be advised of intention to withdraw on medical grounds no later than midnight 31st March 2025 and a medical certificate subsequently submitted to the Meet Co-ordinator within seven days of the last day of the competition. Requests for medical refunds without a medical certificate being submitted may not be considered.
- I) The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

MEET INFORMATION

- 6. Ages will be as of 6th April 2025
- 7. Meet participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at Dorchester Sports Centre and follow instructions of Centre Staff and SSC Meet Management Team. Prior to leaving poolside swimmers must dry off and put on appropriate clothing/footwear. No swimmers will be allowed into the spectator area or the Centre entrance foyer unless they have complied with this requirement. For safety reasons spectators must ensure all gangways and the rear of the spectator area are kept clear; stewards will patrol these areas during the Meet to ensure compliance. Participating clubs are responsible for ensuring that their members are made aware of these Health and Safety requirements and those laid down in Swim England Laws.
- 8. Failure to comply with any condition may result in disqualification and forfeiture of any fee paid.
- 9. A warm-up protocol will be issued with each Coach Information Pack. Lanes will be allocated and announced for the purpose of warm-up. Diving will only be allowed in specified lanes, and at specified times during each warm-up. Coaches are required to ensure that their swimmers adhere to the warm-up procedure or swimmers will be requested to leave the pool.
- 10. Swimmers are responsible for reporting to the Marshalling Area in the shower area of the changing rooms. For the first two events in each session swimmers should report to the Marshalling Area directly after the warm-up. Swimmers in all other events should report to the Marshalling area at least one event before their own event.
- 11. Failure to appear in the designated heat will cancel any right to compete in that event. Competitors who fail to appear in the designated heat of an event may be allowed to swim in empty lanes in that event at the discretion of the Referee, and on a first-come first-served basis.
- 12. Electronic timing will be used; a secondary strobe will be available during this Meet. Swimmers requiring the use of a secondary strobe must advise the meet manager prior to the competition.





- 13. All events will be run as Heat Declared Winner (HDW) and will start at the deep end of the pool. Entries will be seeded on submitted times with the slowest time swimming first. Para-Swim / Disability swimmers will compete in the appropriate time ranked heat. All heats will be spearheaded, with the slowest heat competing first. Over the top starts will be used at the discretion of the Referee. Competitors must leave the pool from the side and not climb over the timing boards.
- 14. There will be no cool down pool available. Please do not let your swimmers play/touch or interact with the small pool cover.
- 15. Mobile phones must not at any time be used in changing rooms or changing spaces.

RESULTS

- 16. Results will be displayed in an appropriate location as soon as they are available. Medals will be awarded to swimmers placed 1st to 3rd in each event and each age group with the exception of any swimmer who has been disqualified. Medals can be collected from the medals table. There will be no formal presentation of medals.
- 17. Awards will be presented to the Top Male/ Open Athlete and Top Female Athlete of the Meet as soon as possible after the completion of the final event. The overall winners will be calculated from points awarded to the top three placings in each event and each age group. We will also be running Hot Heats throughout the competition.
- 18. Medals will be awarded to the top three placed Para-Swim/Disability competitors in each Para-Swim/Disability event which shall be determined on a multi-disability basis.
- 19. A permanent trophy will be presented to the Top Visiting Club as soon as possible after completion of the final event. The winning club will be calculated from points awarded to the top three placings in each event and each age group.

COACHES PASSES & OFFICIALS

- 20. Coaches' passes will be issued at a cost of £20 per person per day or £30 for the weekend. Passes will provide admission to all sessions, programme for the day and refreshments. Coaches, Team Managers and Chaperones who will be on poolside with swimmers are required to complete a coach/team manager/chaperone application form for each person who is required to be on poolside with their club swimmers. Poolside passes must be displayed by coaches/team managers/chaperones at all times.
- 21. All clubs participating must be represented by an L2 or Swim England Swimming Coach on poolside who must have a current Safeguarding certificate and DBS check. All other coaches must be qualified to a minimum L1 standard. Team Managers must be qualified to a minimum TM1 standard and have a current DBS check.





- 22. It is requested that each club with more than eight swimmers entered in this Meet provides at least one qualified official where possible and lunch will be provided. Clubs/swimmers will not be penalised if officials cannot be provided. Please complete the Officials Request Form to volunteer.
- 23. Officials may claim for mileage on receipt of an expense form authorised by the Referee; the rate for mileage is 45p per mile or a maximum of £30 per day, whichever is the lesser.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- 25. Video Recording/Photography/Mobile Telephones: In line with Swim England guidance, parents/carers of participants under the age of 18 years who wish to photograph/video are requested to focus on their own children and avoid including other children in images, particularly if those images are to be shared with family and friends or through social media platforms.
- 26. The policy and procedures of 1610 Sports Centre must be complied with before any photography or video recording is undertaken. Anyone wishing to use a device capable of photography or video recording must take note of the information posters in the venue. The full Guidance on Photography can be found in Wavepower 2020-2023, which is available on the Swim England website http://www.swimming.org/swimengland/wavepower-child-safeguarding-for-clubs/
- 27. An official event photographer invited by the promoter may be in attendance. If you do not wish your child to be photographed, you must advise the registration desk on arrival.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 28. In case of emergency or situations out of our control during the running of the Meet, the Referee may be required to alter the Meet conditions to ensure the smooth running of the event.
- 29. Seagulls SC reserves the right to refuse admission to any Club official, coach, competitor, or spectator who displays inappropriate behaviour, language, or conduct.
- 30. All competitors, or in the case of a minor the parent/guardian of that minor, will be deemed to have accepted the approved and published conditions of this Meet by an entry to participate in this Meet having been submitted.
- 31. The Promoter will endeavour to run this Competition as advertised. However, if:
 - a) The Competition must be cancelled competitors are not eligible for a full refund of entry fees; proportionate refunds may be made but only after the Promoter has covered all incurred costs.
 - b) The Competition must be run either unlicensed or at a lower licence level, competitors are not eligible for a refund of entry fees.
- 32. The Promoter uses a computer, standard and meet management software to manage entries and results. By submitting and accepting entries to the Meet consent is hereby given, as required by the





Data Protection Bill 2018 (GDPR), to the holding of personal information on computer. Certain personal data handled such as name, age, club, recorded and entered times may be made public during or after the meet. All Personal Data will be retained in a confidential manner and access to such Data will be restricted by the Meet Promoter and limited to only those operating the Meet Software to process results. Any entry details provided on paper will be destroyed within one month of the completion of the Meet. Entry information will be held by Seagulls Swimming Club and 1610 Dorchester Sports Centre.
