ANTI-BULLYING POLICY Statement on Intent

We as a club are committed to providing a caring, friendly and safe environment for all of our members so they can train and develop in a relaxed and secure atmosphere. Bullying of any kind is **unacceptable** at our club. If bullying does occur, all members should be able to tell and know that incidents will be dealt with promptly and effectively. We are a *TELLING* club. This means that *anyone* who knows that bullying is happening is expected to tell any of the coaching/teaching staff or a Committee member.

What Is Bullying?

Bullying is the use of aggression with the intention of hurting another person. Bullying results in pain and distress to the victim.

Bullying can be:

•	Emotional	being unfriendly, excluding, tormenting (e.g. hiding clothes,
		threatening gestures)

• Physical pushing, kicking, hitting, punching or any use of violence

• Racist racial taunts, graffiti, gestures

• Sexual unwanted physical contact or sexually abusive comments

Homophobic because of, or focussing on the issue of sexuality
 Verbal name-calling, sarcasm, spreading rumours, teasing

Cyber All areas of internet ,such as email & internet chat room misuse

Mobile threats by text messaging & calls

Misuse of associated technology, i.e. camera &video facilities

Why is it Important to Respond to Bullying?

Bullying hurts. No one deserves to be a victim of bullying. Everybody has the right to be treated with respect. Athletes who are bullying need to learn different ways of behaving.

We as a club have a responsibility to respond promptly and effectively to issues of bullying.

Objectives of this Policy

- All committee members, coaching/ teaching staff, members and parents should have an understanding of what bullying is.
- All committee members, coaching/ teaching staff should know what the clubs policy is on bullying, and follow it when bullying is reported.
- All members and parents should know what the clubs policy is on bullying, and what they should do if bullying arises.
- As a club we take bullying seriously. Members and parents should be assured that they will be supported when bullying is reported.
- Bullying will not be tolerated.

Procedures

- 1. Report bullying incidents to committee members, coaching/ teaching staff
- 2. In cases of serious bullying, the incidents will be recorded by committee members, coaching/ teaching staff In serious cases parents should be informed and will be asked to come in to a meeting to discuss the problem
- 3. If necessary and appropriate, police/ASA will be consulted
- 4. The bullying behaviour or threats of bullying must be investigated and the bullying stopped quickly
- 5. An attempt will be made to help the bully (bullies) change their behaviour

Outcomes

- 1) The bully (bullies) may be asked to genuinely apologise. Other consequences may take place.
- 2) In serious cases, suspension or even exclusion will be considered
- 3) If possible, the pupils will be reconciled
- 4) After the incident / incidents have been investigated and dealt with, each case will be monitored to ensure repeated bullying does not take place.

Prevention

We at Bletchley & District Swim Club use the following methods for helping children to prevent bullying.

- written a set of club rules
- signing a behaviour contract
