




PARKING AND RULES AT KENT COLLEGE

KENT COLLEGE

FOR SWIM SCHOOL LESSONS AND SQUAD SESSIONS THAT TAKE PLACE MONDAY TO FRIDAY

- Please park in the main car park as you enter the school grounds near the field.
- As indicated, swim school, squad members, coaching and teaching staff are NOT allowed to park around the school roundabout or in the gravel car park to the rear of the school building closest to the pool whilst their lessons or squad sessions take place.
- Swimmers should walk up the short slope from the car park to the pool building





KENT COLLEGE

FOR SWIM SCHOOL LESSONS AND SQUAD SESSIONS THAT TAKE PLACE AT THE WEEKENDS

- Please park in the main car park as you enter the school grounds near the field.
- The school roundabout may also be used for parking.
- Swim school and squad members are NOT allowed to park in the gravel car park to the rear of the school building closest to the pool whilst their lessons or squad sessions take place.
- Coaching and teaching staff are allowed to park in the gravel car park to the rear of the school building closest to the pool.
- If parking in the main car park, swimmers should walk up the short slope from this to the pool building.

GENERAL: KENT COLLEGE SITE - As Kent College is a boarding school all our swim school and squad members should also comply with the following rules whilst on-site.

Please do not use any of the facilities, including the swings outside the pool.

Please do not walk around the school site unless sticking to the public footpaths.

DOGS: KENT COLLEGE SITE - Whilst dogs are permitted on the school site, this should only be if you need to take them somewhere whilst waiting for a squad session or swimming lesson to conclude. Please do not use the school site as a parking area before heading off on a long walk with them.

Please also note the following:

Dogs are not allowed in any pool building.

They should be kept on a lead at all times.

Please always clean up after your dog.

Please only walk on public footpaths and not around the school site with them. The closest footpath is in the bottom field next to the main car parking area. Thank you for your co-operation



IMPORTANT - PLEASE NOTE: PERSONAL PROPERTY

Regrettably we have had an incident where a swimmer has had some of their belongings taken from a changing room, so please do remind your swimmers to look after their belongings

This is a reminder to all our members, to please leave valuables at home or leave with parents when in the pool.

When swimming at our pools and especially the public pools, please use lockers available and secure the lockers as, unfortunately, neither the pools nor the club cannot be responsible for any losses or damage to personal belongings.
