

Young Volunteers Programme

South East Swimming are offering a Young Volunteers Programme, where our teenage swimmers can work towards different qualifications. The aim is to differentiate this course from other schemes and to work with the volunteers to identify which area of volunteering interests them the most and what skills they have to offer, giving them access to courses and training with the ultimate aim of them becoming skilled volunteers, who continue to contribute their time to aquatics once this programme finishes. The programme will run from September 2025 to the end of August 2026, and there is a £10 signup fee.

There are three volunteering routes that have been identified at this time although more than one may be chosen. It is important to note that some of the courses do have a cost attached, and attendance at these will be a mandatory requirement.

Volunteers will need a mentor, so please discuss with the appropriate Monson volunteer/coach - email details of which can be found at the end of the newsletter. The routes are:

Route 1 - Poolside Helper

This role is perfect if you think that you would like to potentially work as a teacher or coach later on. In line with WavePower, Swim England's safeguarding policy, all volunteers aged 16+ that wish to assist as poolside helpers must have attended the Safeguarding in Aquatics course, as well as those that turn 16 during the programme. 50% of the cost of this course can be claimed back through the regional bursary for safeguarding (details can be found through the following link: Bursary). Those aged 14+ must attend the foundation safeguarding course. Swim England have also created poolside helper e-learning courses, both core skills and discipline specific, that will need to be completed to start their volunteer programme.

Route 2 - Official

This role is great for those that enjoy the events side of the sport and will open the door to volunteer opportunities at meets beyond the club level. Depending on the level of commitment you may be able to offer, the starting point would be the 1.5 hours timekeeper course before commencing a role in the club officials team; this is available to all volunteers aged 14+. Those wishing to, can go one step further and complete the J1 theory training however, it is important that volunteers who choose to do this, are aware that they should commit to completing the practical element of this role within 11months of the theory – they should be put in touch with the club officials coordinator as mentor, to discuss if this is the best option for them.

Route 3 – Events/Hytek training

You may not be aware of the need for volunteers to support with internal club events and open meets that a club hosts, and this is essential to ensure the success of the event. This route is ideal for any member who prides themselves on their people and/or organisational skills.

For any young tech whizz, we will provide training in using the hytek systems to enable them to support with the pre-event club administration up to the event results. Alongside this there will be a workshop on events detailing the roles and responsibilities that clubs should have in place for a safe and successful event.

Upon signing up to the programme, you will be asked to confirm which welcome workshop you would like to attend, these will take place on the following dates, you only need to attend one.

- Saturday 6th September 9.00am
- Saturday 6th September 5.00pm
- Sunday 7th September at 2.00pm

Please note that when you sign up, you will be asked to provide the name of your mentor, the mentor's role within the club as well as their contact email address so please ensure that you have this information in advance, and that your club committee is able to support you. Please note that Parents will be responsible for the costs, but in the event of this being an issue, members can request financial support from the Helping Hand Fund. Contact the <u>Treasurer</u> if you would like to access support funding

On completion of the welcome workshop, the Region will provide and commit to:

- Sending out a log book to record goal setting, course attendance and achievements
- Provide access to a range of courses (some mandatory) to develop knowledge and skills
- Check in regularly with mentors and volunteers
- Send monthly reminders to evidence courses and submit hours
- Signpost volunteers to event opportunities (club, county and regional)
- Certificates of achievement for milestones in your volunteering journey
