


## PARKING AND RULES AT KENT COLLEGE

Please find below an update regarding parking and our use of the Kent College site whilst our squad and swim school lessons take place

## **KENT COLLEGE**

#### FOR SWIM SCHOOL LESSONS AND SQUAD SESSIONS THAT TAKE PLACE MONDAY TO FRIDAY

- Please park in the main car park as you enter the school grounds near the field.
- As indicated, swim school, squad members, coaching and teaching staff are NOT allowed to park around the school roundabout or in the gravel car park to the rear of the school building closest to the pool whilst their lessons or squad sessions take place.
- Swimmers should walk up the short slope from the car park to the pool building.






# **KENT COLLEGE**

#### FOR SWIM SCHOOL LESSONS AND SQUAD SESSIONS THAT TAKE PLACE AT THE WEEKENDS

- Please park in the main car park as you enter the school grounds near the field.
- The school roundabout may also be used for parking.
- Swim school and squad members are NOT allowed to park in the gravel car park to the rear of the school building closest to the pool whilst their lessons or squad sessions take place.
- Coaching and teaching staff are allowed to park in the gravel car park to the rear of the school building closest to the pool.
- If parking in the main car park, swimmers should walk up the short slope from this to the pool building.





#### **GENERAL: KENT COLLEGE SITE**

As Kent College is a boarding school all our swim school and squad members should also comply with the following rules whilst on-site.

- Please do not use any of the facilities, including the swings outside the pool.
- Please do not walk around the school site unless sticking to the public footpaths.

#### **DOGS: KENT COLLEGE SITE**

Whilst dogs are permitted on the school site, this should only be if you need to take them somewhere whilst waiting for a squad session or swimming lesson to conclude. Please do not use the school site as a parking area before heading off on a long walk with them.

Please also note the following:

- Dogs are not allowed in any pool building.
- They should be kept on a lead at all times.
- Please always clean up after your dog.
- Please only walk on public footpaths and not around the school site with them. The closest footpath is in the bottom field next to the main car parking area.

# Kent Swimming – Job Opportunities

Kent Swimming is looking to appoint two individuals to two newly-created remunerated positions

### **Position 1: Administration Manager**

This position offers approximately eight hours per week encompassing administrative support for various members of the Management Team, including but not limited to the Chair, Secretary, Masters Manager, Competitive Swimming Manager and Artistic Swimming Manager. The position is self-employed and allows for home working.

The KCASA Management Team meets four times a year and attendance at these meetings forms part of the role. Your attendance would also be required at the Annual Council Meeting, usually held in September.

#### **Position 2: Events Manager**

This position offers approximately ten weeks of work per year (35 hours per week) and ultimately leads to being the Meet Promoter for various KCASA Championship events including: Masters, Competitive Swimming and Artistic Swimming.

The position is self-employed and allows for home working. In addition, the nature of the role does require attendance at the events falling under control of the position. The KCASA Management Team meets four times a year and attendance at these meetings forms part of the role. Your attendance would also be required at the Annual Council Meeting, usually held in September.

# South East Regional Open Water Championships

The Open Water Championships of both the Swim England London and Swim England South East provide the only opportunity for qualifying for the Swim England National Championships. In both cases, the top three swimmers (representing a club affiliated to the respective region) in each age-group/gender event will qualify.

This means that to have a chance of qualifying for the National event, members of Kent Rural clubs must swim in the South East event and members of Kent London clubs must swim in the London event.

And we're not just talking about Age Group swimmers, these are events for Masters too! Also, both regional events are open events so whether you belong to a Kent Rural or a Kent London club, you can enter either event for more competitive practice - or just for fun! Masters can also enter the national event on the same basis.

#### Swim England South East Open Water Championships 2025

The South East Region Open Water Swimming Championship event is taking place at Mercers Park, South Nutfield, Redhill RH1 4EU on 29 June with full details available <a href="here">here</a>. Please note that the closing date for entries is Tuesday 17 June 2025.

#### Swim England London Open Water Championships 2025

The London Region Open Water Swimming Championship event is taking place on 6 July 2025 at the Docklands Sailing and Watersports Centre, 235A Westferry Road, Docklands, London E14 3QS with full details available <a href="here">here</a>. Please note that the closing date for entries is 20 June 2025.

These will be held on 26 July (Age Groups) and 27 July (Masters) at the Rother Valley Country Park, Mansfield Road, Sheffield, South Yorkshire S26 5PQ and full details are <a href="here">here</a>
