

TSC Changing Room Policy

- The changing rooms at some pools TSC use for training (POTP, Hurst, Aldershot Garison & Hanworth) are used by both TSC members and members of the public, therefore we have a duty to keep our swimmers safe whilst changing and respect other users & staff of the centre.
- Swimmers must leave the changing rooms in the same state as they found them. Please take your own rubbish and all your belongings home.
- Keep noise levels to a talking level and conversations acceptable for our younger swimmers.
- Swim England **Wavepower**'s changing room policy, **prohibits all use of a mobile phone or device in changing room areas**. Taking indecent images of children (when a child is undressing or nude photos) is illegal; any photography or videography of any kind in a changing room could be compromising.
- Swimmers are to change in individual cubicles where possible.
- Where the changing facilities are mixed, boys and girls should change in separate areas.
- Parents are not permitted to be alone in the changing rooms, whilst children are changing unless their child is of an age/stage where help is required.
- Report any concerns you have about others taking photographs or footage of others in the changing rooms or poolside to the leisure centre duty manager, TSC Coach or TSC Welfare Officer
