(Held Under Swim England Technical Laws)

RULES

FROM 1st January 2024

- 1 Swimmers must be fully paid up members of Tewkesbury Swimming Club by the entry date of any meets entered. A fully paid up member is a swimmer who has paid their current annual club membership fee, current Swim England fee and has paid regular monthly squad fees up to the date of swim.**
- 2 Master swimmers may enter the Club Championships if they are fully made up members by the entry dates of any meets entered.**
- 3 The age group categories for the Club Championships are: 8 and under, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16, 17 & over.**
- 4 All Awards will be presented at Annual Presentation Evening for Season 2023 to those swimmers Age Group Categories: 8 and under, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 and 17 & over**
- 5 The age of a swimmer is at the date of December 31st 2023**
- 6. Club Championships Times, Points and any Swimming Awards can only be achieved at Specific Swim Meets.
These Specific Swim Meets will be either TSC Club Championship Events as determined by the TSC Committee (in line with TSC Coaches recommendations) or designated Club Attended Open Meets as determined by the TSC Committee (in line with TSC Coaches recommendations).**
- 7, Club Records can be made by any Members of Tewkesbury Swimming Club with the following Provisions.**
 - a. Swimmers Must be Fully Paid-Up Member of Tewkesbury Swimming Club for at least 3 Months prior to the Swim**
 - b. Away Swimmers can claim Club Records if they are representing Tewkesbury Swimming Club at the time of the swim, or are performing Representative Duties within Gloucester County ASA, Swim England South West or ESSA.**
 - c. Swims made whilst representing away College/School/University Meets will not be eligible for Club Records**
 - d. The Age for All Club Records shall be at 31st December.**

- e. All Swims must be swum at SE Licensed Meets.
- f. Age Categories will be 9 years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years, 16 years and 17+ years.
- g. Swim Distances will be from 50M to 1500M Inclusive.
- h. Club Records will be Recorded and Stated as Long Course or Short Course dependent of the actual swim.

8. Club Records will be kept by the Competitions Secretary and will be regularly updated.

If a swimmer believes that they have broken a Club Record they should contact the Competition Secretary on tsccompetitions@gmail.com.

They should give the following information:

- a. Swimmer Details. Name, Date of Birth, SE Number
- b. Date of Swim
- c. Category, Open or Female
- d. Event
- e. Time Achieved
- f. Venue of Swim

- 7 For Sprint (50M) Events

Points are awarded as follows: 6 for finishing 1st down to 1 for finishing 6th in their Age Group, for every open sprint event.

Points for all Four Stroke Sprints will be added together and the person (male & female) with the most points in each Age Group will have won their Age Group's Sprint Gold Medal, Second Silver and Third Bronze.

Age Group Categories: 8 and under, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 and 17 & over.

In addition, Two Overall Sprint Trophies, one for a Male Swimmer and one for a Female Swimmer will be awarded at the Annual Presentation Evening.

8. For Male and Female Swimmers who are 8 and under, 25M Events will be held for all Four Strokes.

Points and medals will be awarded as for above 50M swims.

Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded for those Male and Female swimmers finishing in overall 1st to 3rd places.

- 9 100M Group Trophies

In the 100M Events, points are awarded in their Age Group,

Age Group Categories: 8 and under, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 and 17 & over

Points for all Four Strokes and IM are awarded as follows: 6 for finishing 1st down to 1 for finishing 6th for each individual event.

Those Swimmers, Male and Female gaining the most points in these 100M events, in their age group at the end of the Championships will receive an Age Group Trophy, which will be presented at the Annual Presentation Evening.

10 Overall Open 100M and Distance Championships events are as follows:

**100m Freestyle
100m Backstroke
100m Breaststroke
100m Butterfly
100m IM
200m Freestyle
200m Backstroke
200m Breaststroke
200m Butterfly
200m IM
400m Freestyle
400m IM
800m Freestyle
1500m Freestyle.**

First Place Awards for Male and Female Swimmers in each event will be awarded at the Annual Presentation Evening.

- 11 All trophies are the property of Tewkesbury Swimming Club and must be returned to the club immediately on cessation of membership. Trophies will not be presented to swimmers who have left Tewkesbury Swimming Club but their names will be engraved on the trophy.**
- 12 Previous winners of cup/trophies must return them to any committee member when requested, in order to allow time for them to be engraved for the next winner prior to the presentation evening.**
- 13 Where a swimmer has dual membership, in order to be eligible to receive a trophy or be awarded a Club Championship Record, the swimmer must have Tewkesbury Swimming Club listed as their main club and place of training. University swimmers are exempt from this rule where their university is listed as their main club.**
