## FINAL INFORMATION

- **Parking** at Woodside is permitted only in marked bays. Watford Borough Council has agreed to suspend the maximum 4-hour stay over the weekend of our open meet. It is still necessary to obtain and display a ticket upon arrival, ensuring that you park within a marked bay. The Centre can be busy during the summer months due to the athletics stadium on site, so please allow sufficient time to park.
- **Swimmer access:**
  - **Saturday:** Changing rooms from 12:35 PM and the poolside at 12:45 PM.
  - **Sunday:** Changing rooms from 8:35 AM and to the poolside at 8:45 AM.
  - This allows Woodside sufficient time to complete classes and prepare the pool for the event.
  - If you arrive earlier, please utilize the café or outdoor spaces.
- **Swimmers Poolside:**
  - Swimmers will find on entry to the pool area that each club has been allocated a space to sit and put their bags.
  - Please remind your swimmers not to place their bags or themselves on top of the vents that run around the windows as this increases the temperature inside the building.
- **Spectators' entry** is £5 per session. Space in the viewing gallery is limited, and once these tickets/wristbands are sold out, no further tickets will be available for that session. Spectators of all ages, other than babies sat on laps, will require purchase of a ticket. Card payment is preferred.
- The pool area and the spectator's gallery may be warm. There is outside space behind the leisure centre where you can get fresh air and eat your food during breaks. It's also advisable to dress appropriately to stay cool.
- **The café at the Centre** is run by Everyone Active, it provides a range of hot and cold drinks and food. The café should be open until 9 pm on Saturday and from 8.30am until 5pm on Sunday, however sometimes it does close early so bring a water bottle. If the weather is nice within a 15-minute walk (turning left out of the Centre) you can reach a Simmons Bakers and a Tesco Express both of which have sandwiches and drinks available.
- Results on the day will be available via **Meet Mobile** and displayed in the spectator area.
- There will be an external **swim shop** company on site for most of the meet – to restock on all your swimming supplies and reward your swimmers' efforts with the latest swimming apparel and accessories! They will be based by the gym which is on the left as you come up the stairs towards the pool spectator area.
- This is an active **withdrawal** meet so if you know now your swimmer can no longer make it or wants to withdraw from a race, please let your coach or meet entry organiser know as soon as possible.
- **Please remind your swimmers that they cannot use their mobile phones in the changing areas, as we marshal through this area this also means while they are queuing for their races.**
