

Swimming Lesson Helper / Poolside Helper Role

Key Responsibilities:

- Following instructions of qualified teachers and assistant teachers to support delivery of the session.
- Supporting teachers with helping to set up and tidy away any equipment used during the session.
- To be aware of the safety of the session at all times, ensuring the poolside is tidy and any health and safety risks are reported to the teacher.
- Attending sessions requested by Learn to Swim Co-ordinator.
- Assisting poolside with lessons and when requested in the water, under direct supervision of a teacher.

Key Skills:

- Good communication skills especially with young swimmers.
- Ability to motivate and encourage.
- Passionate and enthusiastic for teaching swimming.
- Patient and calm.
- Child Protection and Safeguarding if aged over 16.
- Flexible.

Qualifications and Experience:

Required

- Be at least 14 years of age.
- DBS clearance & SE Safeguarding course attendance if aged 16 or over.
- Completion of online Swimming Lesson Helper course.
